Summary (continued)

Programs available include the California Disaster Assistance Act (CDAA), the Emergency Management Assistance Compact (EMAC), Federal Disaster Assistance, and the Fire Management Assistance Grant (FMAG).

In order to be eligible for this assistance, CalOES requires a new Designation of Applicant's Agent Resolution for Disaster Relief and Emergency Services submittal every three (3) years.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

By submitting this resolution, there is no impact on the citizens or businesses within the County; however, if a disaster occurs, this resolution will provide a substantial benefit in that it will enable the County to apply for and be eligible for disaster relief and emergency assistance that, given the gravity of the disaster, the County may not be equipped to provide on its own.


