BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) sets forth the terms and conditions by which California State University San Bernardino (CSUSB) will digitally copy the District's historic aerial photo collection to meet the District's and CSUSB's goals.

BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

The District retains an archive of historic aerial photographs and desires to digitize its extensive aerial photo collection to allow the collection to provide more convenient public access, to reduce the wear and tear on the photos themselves, and to preserve the collection. CSUSB wishes to supplement its own historic aerial photograph collection with the District's historic aerial photo collection and to make electronic copies for ease of public access and educational purposes.

County Counsel has approved the MOU as to legal form and CSUSB has executed the MOU.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

This project entails no new fees, taxes or bonded indebtedness to citizens and businesses. Once digitized, the digital copy of the District's and CSUSB's historic aerial photograph collection will benefit citizens and businesses by providing more convenient public access to the historic collection.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

by and between

RIVERSIDE COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT

and

CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY SAN BERNARDINO

for

AERIAL PHOTOGRAPH COLLECTION IMAGING

WHEREAS, the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation

District (hereinafter referred to as "District") retains an archive of historic aerial photographs;

and

WHEREAS, DISTRICT desires to digitize its extensive aerial photo collection to allow the collection to provide more convenient public access, to reduce the wear and tear on the photos themselves, and to preserve the collection; and

WHEREAS, the California State University San Bernardino (hereinafter referred to as "CSUSB") wishes to supplement its own historic aerial photograph collection with the DISTRICT'S historic aerial photo collection and to make electronic copies for ease of public access and educational purposes; and

WHEREAS, CSUSB proposes to digitally copy DISTRICT'S aerial photo collection to meet DISTRICT'S and CSUSB'S goals; and

WHEREAS, the output of the digitization process will be high-quality, high-resolution electronic image files that will also include pertinent meta-data (e.g., photo date, location, source) that will be imbedded in each file; and

WHEREAS, certain data about the photos will be provided by DISTRICT and additional data may be added by CSUSB.

NOW THEREFORE, the DISTRICT and CSUSB mutually agree to the following terms and conditions:

I. CSUSB ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- A. CSUSB Archivist shall arrange a mutually acceptable time to pick up the DISTRICT'S original photographic prints (i.e., "aerial photos" or "aerial photo collection") from DISTRICT'S office. Prior to DISTRICT'S release of any photographs to the Archivist, the Archivist shall sign DISTRICT'S release form identifying the particular aerial photos that are being taken and the projected return date. Each set of aerial photos shall be returned to DISTRICT within ten (10) working days from the date of checkout.
- B. CSUSB Archivist shall assume sole responsibility for the aerial photos until they are returned to DISTRICT'S office.
- C. The aerial photos, while at CSUSB, will be stored in archival boxes and securely housed at CSUSB except when actively being digitized.
- D. In the event of any unanticipated delay, CSUSB Archivist shall immediately notify DISTRICT regarding the status of the digitizing process and give an estimated time for the return of the aerial photos to DISTRICT office. It will be in DISTRICT'S sole discretion to approve the delay, but the approval will not be unreasonably withheld.
- E. CSUSB Archivist shall be responsible for properly training students and others who may handle the aerial photos while they are at CSUSB. Students and/or other persons working with/for CSUSB are not employees of DISTRICT, and CSUSB shall be solely responsible for provision of any worker's compensation benefits or other liabilities that may arise from the provision of services by students and others working on behalf of CSUSB.

F. CSUSB Archivist shall return the aerial photos to DISTRICT offices in the same condition in which they were removed, each time checking the photos back into DISTRICT with its designated staff.

- G. CSUSB Archivist shall make electronic digital images of DISTRICT'S aerial photograph collection that is provided to CSUSB pursuant to this MOU.
- H. The work shall be accomplished by CSUSB students with supervision by CSUSB Archives Manager and University Photographer at CSUSB's own expense.
- I. CSUSB agrees to retain its completed collection of electronic images indefinitely, to exercise reasonable care to preserve and protect it from the elements, to publicize its existence in appropriate campus publications, newsletters, or flyers, and to organize it for use for access to CSUSB and to the public.
- J. CSUSB may use these images to make copies both printed and electronic that can be used to inform students, faculty, researchers and the public and/or display these images in appropriate ways.
- K. Should CSUSB cease to use this collection for educational purposes, the Pfau Library of CSUSB shall serve as the repository of this collection.
- L. CSUSB shall include the following disclaimer with said historical aerial photographs:

"The aerial photographs available by and through the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District ("District") are presented as a public resource of general information. They are not certified records of the District. While the District strives to maintain the accuracy of the content of its data files, it makes no claims, promises, or guarantees about the accuracy, completeness, or adequacy of the contents

of the files. The District assumes no liability whatsoever to CSUSB or any third party arising from use of the information provided and the information is provided "as is". No warranty of any kind, expressed or implied, including but not limited to, the implied warranties of merchantability and fitness for particular purposes is made. It is the responsibility of the recipient of this data to determine that the level of accuracy meets the needs of their application prior to making any judgments or decisions based on this information. The District is not responsible for any damages that may arise from the use of, or inability to use, the information provided."

M. CSUSB shall furnish DISTRICT with an exact duplicate electronic copy in ".jpg" format of all electronic image files and their metadata produced under this MOU. DISTRICT shall, at its sole cost and expense, provide the memory storage device(s) for the files produced.

N. DISTRICT shall receive full recognition as donor in all instances, including websites, printed publications, in metadata, and every citation where appropriate. All citations will be as follows:

II. DISTRICT ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- DISTRICT shall furnish an electronic spreadsheet identifying its flight data to CSUSB.
- B. DISTRICT shall not bear any responsibility or liability whatsoever for the accuracy of any data added by CSUSB in the course of its production of any electronic image files.

- C. DISTRICT shall be solely responsible for determining the order in which the aerial photos shall be released to CSUSB.
- D. DISTRICT has the sole right to select which of its aerial photographs are to be released to CSUSB.
- E. DISTRICT will waive copyright infringement for those photos for which it holds all rights so that CSUSB may digitize these images to make prints or digital copies that can be used to inform students, faculty, researchers and the public and/or display these images in appropriate ways.
- F. DISTRICT may utilize, print or otherwise publish the electronic image files furnished by CSUSB pursuant to this MOU in any manner it deems to be in the public interest.

III. MUTUAL UNDERSTANDING

- A. CSUSB may sell copies of the electronic image files produced pursuant to this MOU, or prints thereof, to interested parties for an appropriate fee as determined by CSUSB.
- B. DISTRICT may sell copies of electronic image files produced pursuant to this MOU, or prints thereof, to interested parties for a fee set by DISTRICT to cover its cost of service.
- C. To minimize the impact to DISTRICT'S aerial photograph users, CSUSB and DISTRICT shall develop a mutually agreeable schedule for processing DISTRICT'S aerial photo collection.
- D. The digital images of the photos produced pursuant to this MOU and subsequently provided to the public are not to be considered certified copies of DISTRICT'S aerial photo collection. As such, DISTRICT makes no warranties, expressed or implied.

E. CSUSB wishes to be considered for housing the original physical aerial photo collection if at any time DISTRICT chooses to divest itself of its aerial photo collection.

IV. TERM

A. This MOU shall take effect on the date it is signed by both parties and will remain in effect until the collection of photos is copied, or four (4) years, whichever occurs earlier. Either party may terminate this MOU at any time and for any reason with 30 days' notice to the other party. Upon termination all photos still "checked out" shall be immediately returned to DISTRICT and DISTRICT shall receive an electronic copy of any photos provided to and digitized by CSUSB.

B. The General Manager-Chief Engineer, or his/her appointed designee, is authorized to exercise DISTRICT'S rights with respect to any termination of this MOU. CSUSB Director, or his/her appointed designee, has authority to terminate this MOU on behalf of CSUSB. Termination of this MOU, once digital images have been completed, does not preclude CSUSB from continuing to use, display and house copies of said digital images. Such use shall be governed by the terms of this MOU.

V. INDEMNIFICATION

A. CSUSB agrees to indemnify, defend (with counsel reasonably approved by DISTRICT) and hold harmless DISTRICT and their authorized officers, employees, agents and volunteers from any and all claims, actions, losses, damages, and/or liability arising out of this contract from any cause whatsoever, including the acts, errors or omissions of any person and for any costs or expenses incurred by DISTRICT on account of any claim except where such indemnification is prohibited by law. This indemnification provision

shall survive any termination of this MOU and shall apply regardless of the existence or degree of fault of indemnities.

B. DISTRICT agrees to indemnify, defend (with counsel reasonably approved by CSUSB) and hold harmless CSUSB and their authorized officers, employees, agents and volunteers from any and all claims, actions, losses, damages, and/or liability arising out of this contract from any cause whatsoever, including the acts, errors or omissions of any person and for any costs or expenses incurred by CSUSB on account of any claim except where such indemnification is prohibited by law. This indemnification provision shall survive any termination of this MOU and shall apply regardless of the existence or degree of fault of indemnities.

VI. INSURANCE

A. DISTRICT and CSUSB are authorized self-insured public entities for purposes of Professional Liability, General Liability, Automobile Liability and Workers' Compensation and warrant that through their respective programs of self insurance, they have adequate coverage or resources to protect against liabilities arising out of the performance of the terms, conditions or obligations of this MOU.

VII. NOTICES

A. Any and all notices sent or required to be sent to the parties of this Agreement shall be mailed by first class mail, postage prepaid, to the following addresses:

VIII. GENERAL PROVISIONS

A. Any alterations, variations, modifications, or waivers of provisions of the MOU, unless specifically allowed in the MOU, shall be valid only when they have been reduced to writing, duly signed and approved by both parties as an amendment to this MOU. No oral understanding or agreement not incorporated herein shall be binding on any of the parties hereto.

IX. CONCLUSION

- A. This MOU, consisting of 10 pages, is the full and complete document describing services to be rendered by CSUSB to DISTRICT including all covenants, conditions and benefits.
- B. The signatures of the parties affixed to this MOU affirm that they are duly authorized to commit and bind their respective departments to the terms and conditions set forth in this document.
- C. This MOU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of California without regard to its conflict of law principles.
- D. This MOU embodies the entire agreement and understanding of the parties and supersedes all prior negotiations, agreements, and understandings among the parties with respect to subject matter of this MOU.
