**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The County Transportation Improvement Program provides for the construction of a sidewalk along Whittier Avenue between Yale Street and Cornell Street. This project proposes to construct approximately 1,200 linear feet of new curb and gutter and 2,400 linear feet of sidewalk within two segments of Whittier Avenue, providing a safe path for children walking to Ramona Elementary School. The first segment will be on the south side of Whittier Avenue from Yale Street to Columbia Street, and the second segment will be on the north side of Whittier Avenue from Columbia Street to Cornell Street. In addition to the sidewalk improvements, damaged curb and gutter will be removed and replaced, and various Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) access ramps will be upgraded.

The County of Riverside (County) was successful in obtaining \$270,000 of Federal Safe Routes to School funds (SRTS) to provide a safe path for children walking to Ramona Elementary School. The SRTS program was developed to increase the number of children who walk and bicycle to school by removing barriers that prevent them from doing so.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel, and environmental clearance is complete.

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$450,000. Construction will be funded with Federal Safe Routes to School funds and SB-821 Local Transportation funds for bicycle and pedestrian facilities, both of which the County successfully competed, and Measure A/Western funds. There are no General Funds used in this project.

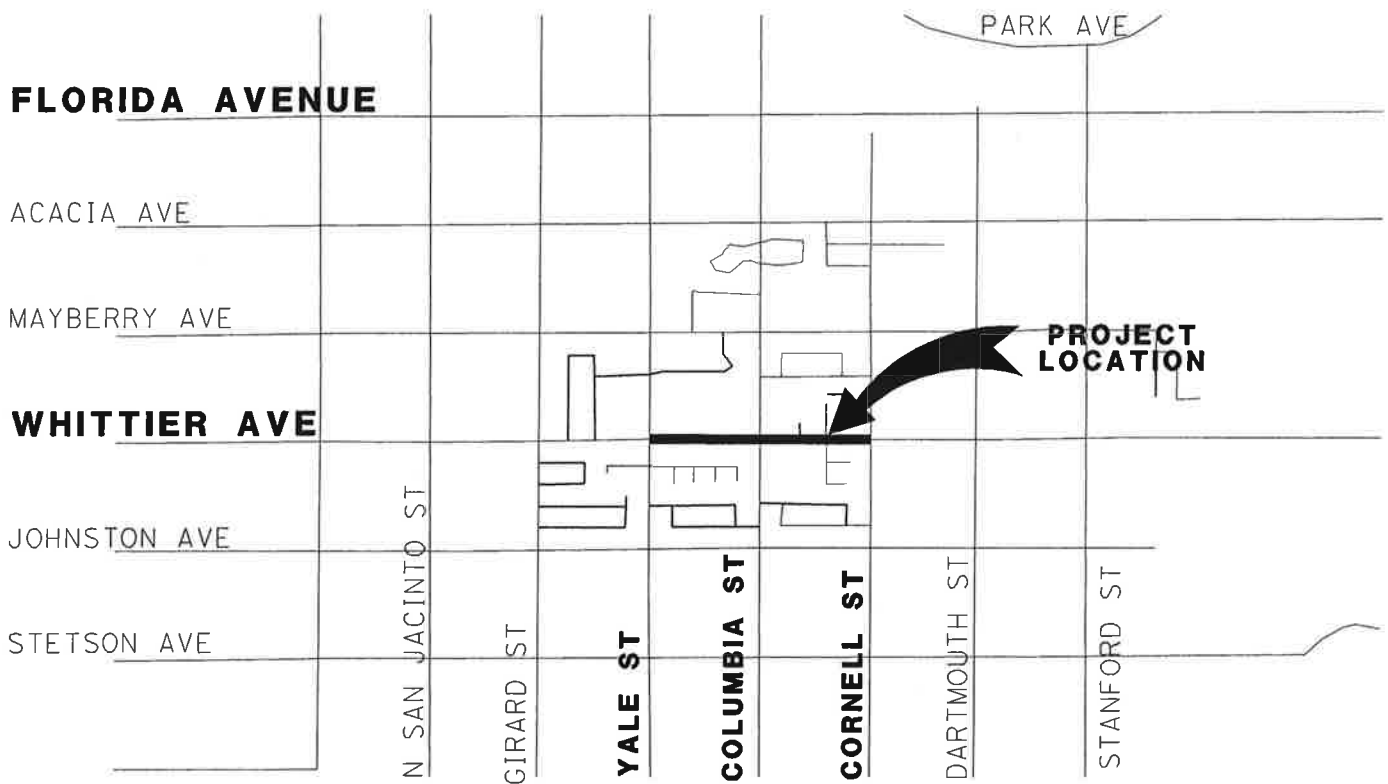
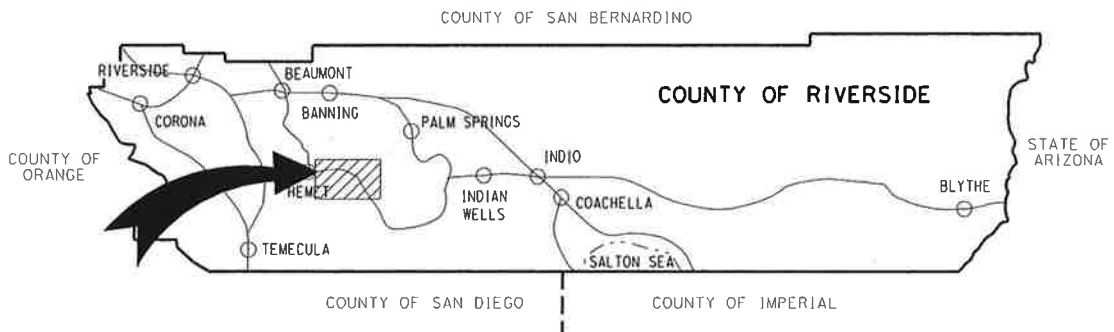
