BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County Transportation Improvement Program provides for the construction of the Washington Street and Krameria Avenue traffic signal, resurfacing of Washington Street between Van Buren Boulevard and Krameria Avenue, and a new sidewalk between Van Buren Boulevard and Krameria Avenue along King Avenue. The Washington Street and Krameria Avenue Signal Project includes the installation of a traffic signal and lights at the intersection of Washington Street and Krameria Avenue and the addition of left turn pockets, new curb returns, access ramps, and concrete cross gutters. These improvements will alleviate school traffic congestion and improve pedestrian access during school hours.

The Washington Street Resurfacing Project includes the widening of Washington Street by seven feet and the resurfacing of Washington Street between Van Buren Boulevard and Krameria Avenue, including the intersection at Krameria Avenue.

The King Avenue Sidewalk Project includes the construction of new sidewalk on the west side of King Avenue, from Van Buren Boulevard to Krameria Avenue, to provide a safe walking path for students to Woodcrest Elementary School.

All three projects are in the community of Woodcrest.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Environmental clearance is complete.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The proposed improvements will improve traffic operations, provide access ramps compliant with the Americans with Disability Act (ADA), and improve roadway safety for pedestrians, students, parents, and motorists.

The new road surface will extend the life of the road by at least 15 years.

Construction will take place during school recess in order to reduce the impacts and disruption to students attending Woodcrest Elementary School.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$1,050,000. The projects will be funded with Proposition 1B (State Bond Funds – Local Streets and Roads), SB-821 (Local Transportation Funds), for which the County of Riverside successfully competed for and obtained, West County DIF Signal Mitigation Fund, and Gas Tax (New HUTA). There are no General Funds used for these projects.

Annual operation and maintenance costs for the traffic signal are estimated at \$5,500 and will be funded by gas tax.

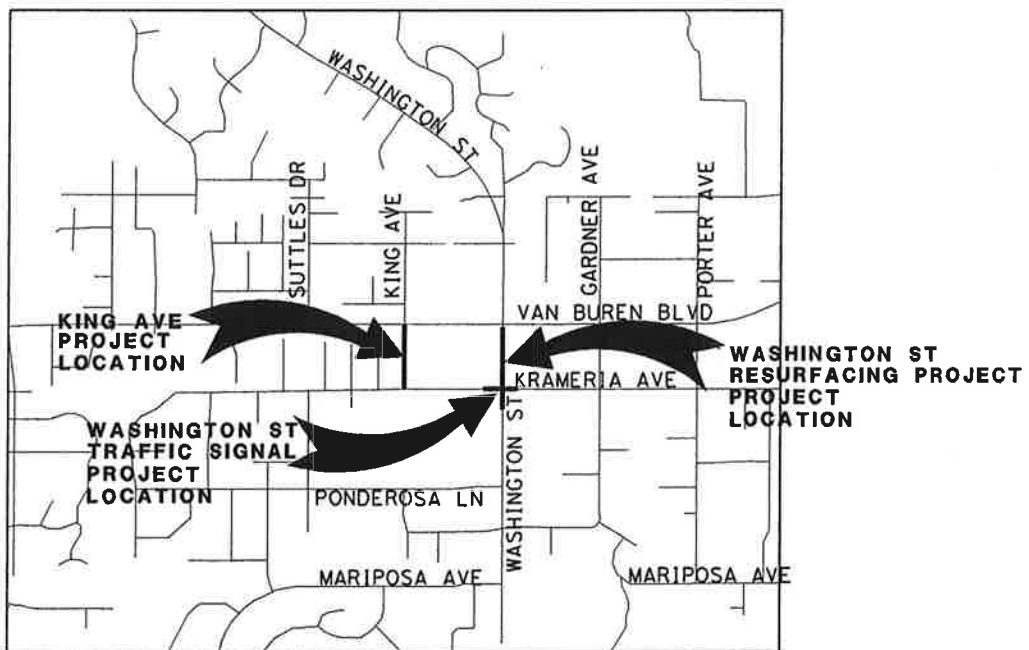
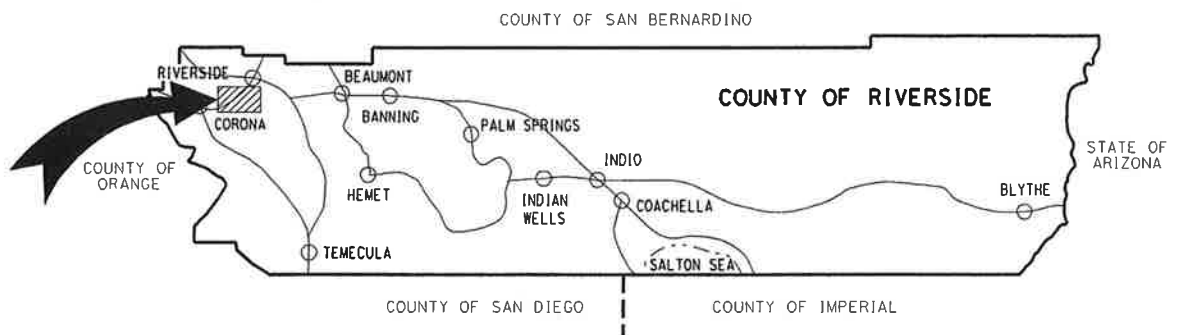
