A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE ADDING ALTERNATES TO THE LAKELAND VILLAGE COMMUNITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, Government Code section 31010 allows for the creation of a community council within unincorporated territory of a county for the purpose of advising the Board of Supervisors on matters including, but not limited to, public health, safety, welfare, public works, and planning;

WHEREAS, in a regular session on February 11, 2014 the Board of Supervisors approved the formation of the Lakeland Village Community Council ("Council") and adopted Resolution No. 2014-057, which included five council members and no alternates;

WHEREAS, there has been considerable community interest in serving on the Council;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors deems it appropriate to add alternates to the current Council to allow more members of the community to serve and reflect the needs of the community.

BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that two (2) alternates will be added to the Council that can step into the place of an absent member, or into a vacant Council seat, until a permanent appointment is made.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that an alternates will serve a two year term, unless sooner removed by the Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the requirements for membership as adopted in the Resolution 2014-057 on February 11, 2014 will apply to all alternate appointments.

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-057

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE CREATING THE LAKELAND VILLAGE COMMUNITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, Government Code section 31010 allows for the creation of a community council within unincorporated territory of a county for the purpose of advising the Board of Supervisors on matters including, but not limited to, public health, safety, welfare, public works, and planning; and

WHEREAS, creation of a Community Council has been requested by residents within the Lakeland Village area of Riverside County, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside. State of California, in a regular session on February 11, 2014 that the Lakeland Village Community Council is hereby created.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the operation of the Lakeland Village Community Council shall be in compliance with the rules, regulations and procedures prescribed in Riverside County Board of Supervisors Policy No. A-51, and with the specific provisions delineated below in this Resolution.

- 1. TERRITORY. The territory for which the Lakeland Village Community Council is established. and area over which it extends, is situated within the area generally known as Lakeland Village in the First Supervisorial District of Riverside County as more specifically shown and depicted in the attached map and legal description, labeled Exhibit A.
- 2. MEMBERSHIP. The Lakeland Village Community Council shall consist of five (5) regular members, each of who shall be appointed by and serve at large at the pleasure of the District Supervisor. All appointees shall be a registered voter, at least eighteen (18) years of age, and be a resident within the Lakeland Village Community Council territory described in Exhibit A.
- TERM. Appointed members shall serve without compensation for a term of four (4) years. However in order to establish a system of staggered terms, two members initially appointed

shall serve a two-year term and three members initially appointed shall serve a four-year term. Appointments made upon the expiration of the terms of the initial members shall be for four years.

4. BOARD POLICY NO. A-51. The provisions of Board of Supervisors Policy No. A-51 on the subject of "Formation/Operation of Municipal Advisory Councils and Community Councils" are incorporated in to this Resolution by reference, and are intended for the guidance of the Lakeland Village Community Council.
