BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Riverside Public Library Foundation - \$1,000** funding will be used to purchase hardback books, which is greatly needed at the Casa Blanca Branch Library,
2. **Riverside Sports Commission- \$1,500** to support their efforts to provide maximum seating, shade and other services for athletes/coaches/officials and spectators for three upcoming international aquatics events this summer.
3. **Riverside Community College District Foundation - \$1000** funding will be used to continue the foundations efforts to provide scholarship and programmatic support to Riverside Community College District students that reside in the First District.
