BACKGROUND:

Summary

On March 12, 2013, the Board awarded Sukut Construction, Inc. the contract to construct the composite liner system within a 23-acre area (referred to as Phase 2, Stage 4 Expansion) at the Lamb Canyon Sanitary Landfill. The total original contract amount was \$10,504,231.50. (continued)

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BACKGROUND:

Summary (Continued)

On April 8, 2014, the Board approved Contract Change Order No. 1 (CCO No.1) in the amount of \$448,000.92 to this contract with Sukut for flood damage repair work performed during construction of this project.

On March 22, 2014, construction of this project was satisfactorily completed on time and within budget. The Department has accepted the work and the regulatory agencies have already approved the constructed liner system; therefore, the Department recommends filing a Notice of Completion. The total approved contract amount, including CCO No.1, was \$10,952,232.42, and the final cost for the project is \$10,863,049.45, which is approximately 1% under the authorized budget.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

If this landfill expansion project was not completed on schedule, the disposal services for the public that is served by the Lamb Canyon Landfill could have been interrupted or halted. It should be noted this expansion project provides landfill airspace for an additional 10.5 million tons of refuse which is projected to extend the remaining site life by approximately 15-20 years.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

This is an administrative action to file the Notice of Completion, no additional funds are being requested. The total final contract cost is approximately 1% under the authorized budget for this project which was originally awarded based on competitive bid process with Sukut Construction, Inc. submitting the lowest bid out of six (6) bids received.
