RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Authorize the County Purchasing Agent to approve the agreements with the attached vendors, without seeking competitive bids;
2. Authorize the County Purchasing Agent to exercise the option to renew agreements annually for up to four (4) additional years, in one-year increments, providing the unit/supplies do not exceed the Consumer Price Index (CPI) or to enter into long-term agreements (up to five years) when an option to terminate without cause with a 30 or 60 day written notice is present;
3. Authorize the County Purchasing Agent, in accordance with Ordinance No. 459 to increase or decrease the agreements listed in Attachment A, while staying within the approved aggregate amount of \$121,221,120 based upon the availability of funding, and to sign amendments which do not change the substantive terms of the agreement through June 30, 2019;

BACKGROUND:

Summary

On February 24, 2004, the Board of Supervisors approved Agenda Item 3.30 for the purchase of surgical instruments, supplies, and implants from various vendors to allow the Hospital an opportunity to compile purchase history, evaluate, and to further verify the need to continue with proprietary contracts. The Board subsequently approved a list of all vendors on July 11, 2006, Agenda Item 3.52, and on June 26, 2007, Agenda Items 3.51 and 3.52.

This request would bring our vendor list current while working with Huron on various initiatives to secure the lowest overall cost for proprietary contracts. The attached spreadsheet lists new and previously approved vendors, annual expenditures for each vendor, commodities, and net cost to the County.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Purchasing from proprietary contracts will allow our Physicians to cost-effectively treat patients residing in Riverside County who receive care from Riverside County Regional Medical Center.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

The vendors listed in "Attachment A" certify that the prices being offered to RCRMC are the lowest offered to any comparable customer. Prices offered are Federal, State, or Local Government Pricing. RCRMC currently receives a maximum discount for purchases as a member of the Group Purchasing Organizations (GPO). The County receives discounts equal to comparable customers while continuing to utilize the GPO's for purchases. Detailed analysis has been conducted by Purchasing and the Value Analysis Committee which have deemed these prices to be competitive.

4. **Extent of market search conducted:** Internet/ Market Research/ Personal Contact with further review with Huron.
5. **Unique features of the supply/service being requested from this supplier, which no alternative supplier can provide:** Each of these vendors have unique items in regards to their respective commodity "See Attachment A". These unique items permit our Physicians to treat patients with a variety of means to allow procedures to be less invasive and to further broaden our ability to treat patients with superior care in a timely manner.
