BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Agua Mansa Road and Market Street Traffic Signal and Street Improvement Project includes the installation of a new traffic signal and intersection lighting, pavement reconstruction, curbs, ramps, and associated street improvements.

Although the project is located within the City of Jurupa Valley (City), the design of the project and securing of funding started before the incorporation of the City.

The bid documents include the following five schedules of work:

Base Bid Schedule A: (Traffic Signal and Street Improvements)

Base Bid Schedule B: (Storm Drain Improvement - Flood Control Facility)

Alternate Bid Schedule 1: (Market Street Pavement Rehabilitation, Sta. 16+50.00 to Sta. 19+25)

Alternate Bid Schedule 2: (Market Street Pavement Rehabilitation, Sta. 10+00 to Sta. 12+50)

Alternate Bid Schedule 3: (Rubidoux Community Services District, RCSD)

Alternate Bid Schedules 1 and 2 for additional pavement reconstruction, if approved by the City, would be funded by the City through a reimbursement agreement to be approved by the Board of Supervisors prior to or concurrent with the award of the construction contract.

Alternate Bid Schedule 3, if approved and concurred by RCSD as bid by the apparent low bidder, the cost of this work will be funded by the RCSD.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Environmental clearance is complete.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The construction of the traffic signal will improve traffic operations and safety through the intersection. Intersection improvements also include construction of curb ramps to comply with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements and other associated improvements.

Construction is expected to occur in FY 2014/2015 and will be funded by the Federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP), the City of Jurupa Valley, West County Development Impact Fee (DIF) Signal Mitigation Funds, the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District, miscellaneous (RCSD), and miscellaneous (Burrtec Waste Industries cash-in-lieu-of-construction deposit). There are no General Funds used in this project.

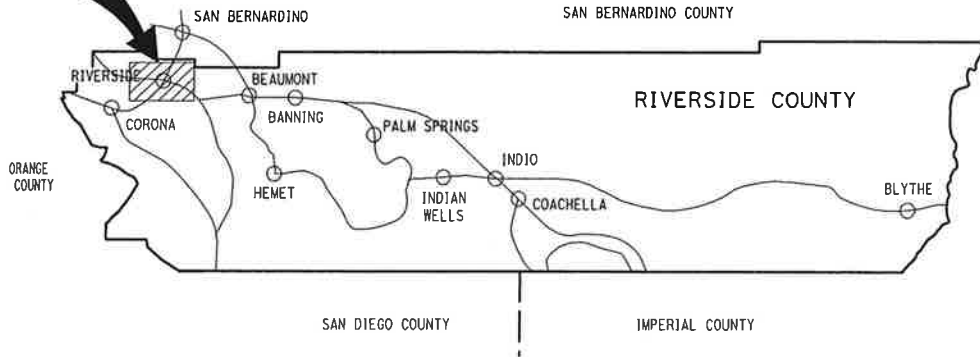

IN THE CITY OF JURUPA VALLEY

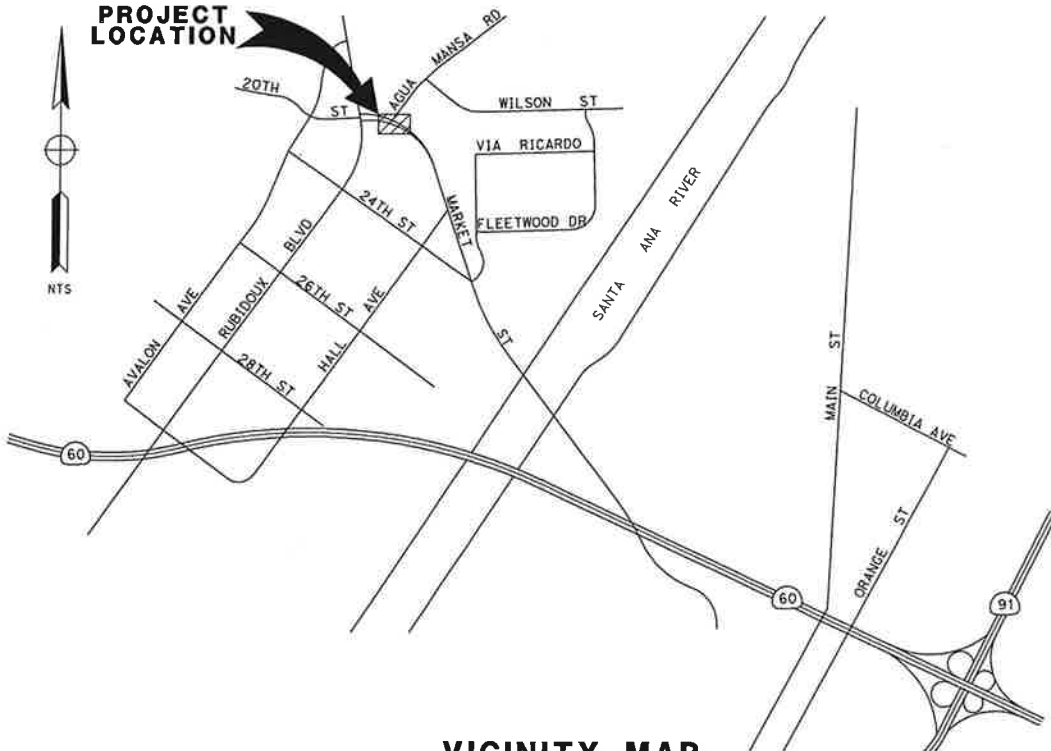

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE
AUTHORIZING COMPLETION OF PROJECT SERVICES TO THE CITY OF JURUPA
VALLEY FOR LIMONITE AND ETIWANDA IMPROVEMENTS**

WHEREAS, the County began design of, and securing funding for, the Agua Mansa Road and Market Street Traffic Signal and Street Improvement Project prior to incorporation of the City of Jurupa Valley; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jurupa Valley was incorporated on July 1, 2011, as a general law city of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the City considered the Agua Mansa Road and Market Street intersection improvement project (the "Project") as a priority, which involves installing traffic signal and safety lighting system at the intersection, installing catch basins on Agua Mansa Road and resurfacing Market Street, and instructed City staff to work with the County regarding the construction of this Project; and

WHEREAS, City staff at March 18, 2014 approved and signed the proposed Project plans allowing the County to move forward with Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside assembled in regular session on May 6, 2014, at 9:00 a.m., in the meeting room of the Board of Supervisors located on the 1st floor of the County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California, by a four-fifths vote, that the Board:

1. Finds and declares that the above recitals are true and correct.
2. Finds and determines that the improvement as described above is of general County interest per Streets and Highways Code Section 1686.
3. Finds that funds in the form of Federal Aid, Number HSIPL-5956(190) have been secured for the Project, and further that County shall provide labor to oversee the Project.
4. Authorizes that County aid and funds identified for this Project can be extended to perform said

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activities within the City's jurisdiction and hereby agrees to complete the Project at an estimated full cost of Six Hundred Forty-Seven Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-One Dollars (\$647,661), for which the City will not participate.
