## **BACKGROUND:**

#### Summary

The County Transportation Improvement Program provides for the construction of the Ellis Avenue Sidewalk Improvement Project, between Marshall Street and Cowie Avenue in the Community of Good Hope.

Ellis Avenue is the major east-west pedestrian route for Good Hope Elementary School. The existing dirt shoulder along Ellis Avenue currently contains obstructions, such as fences, trees, and random landscape and hardscape. This project proposes to remove all existing obstructions and construct approximately 1,850 linear feet of new sidewalk, including three new access ramps. Other project features include accessible driveways, drainage improvements, and school zone flashing beacons. Marked crosswalks and associated signage will also be installed at the intersection of Ellis Avenue at Marshall Street and at Cowie Avenue.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel, and environmental clearance is complete.




