The District needs to repower the John Deere Backhoe Loader, Model 4010G. Upgrading to a Tier III Engine allowing the District to stay in compliance with California Air Resource Board - "CARB", using the latest Best Available Control Technology - "BACT" mandated by the State.

BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

The current Tier II Engine has had ongoing mechanical issues with the Particulate Trap (PM), large amounts of oil are being used and the trap is continuously plugging, causing the engine to overheat and shutdown, which in turn, creates various repairs and replacement of parts within the engine. The best course of action is to upgrade the engine to Tier III technology which eliminates having to use the PM, making the engine more reliable and emission efficient. The Tier III Engine and the accompanying software are proprietary to the manufacturer, John Deere. The work must be done by an authorized distributor and servicer of John Deere, and RDO Equipment Company is the local Riverside authorized distributor and servicer certified in John Deere repowers and repairs. The repower with the Tier III Engine is estimated at \$29,448.03 with a not to exceed amount of \$32,448.03.
