BACKGROUND:

Summary

On January 28, 2014 (3-6) the Board approved LIHEAP Agreement #14B-5028 in the amount of \$1,112,290 which provides funding for the term January 1, 2014 through January 31, 2015. LIHEAP Program funding is to assist low-income consumers with high energy bills, repair or replace heating and cooling devices that contribute to high energy consumption, and weatherize homes.

Amendment #1 to Agreement #14B-5028 increased the maximum amount of the agreement from \$1,112,290 to \$4,328,289, which reflected an increase of \$3,215,999.

Amendment #2 to Agreement #14B-5028 increases the maximum amount of the agreement from \$4,328,289 to \$5,970,221, reflecting an increase of \$1,641,932.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The LIHEAP program provides utility payment assistance and installation of energy conservation measures designed to reduce energy costs and make homes safer and healthier for low-income households.

Additional Fiscal Information

No County General Funds will be required.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

The LIHEAP Contract is a federal contract administered by CAP Riverside since 1979. LIHEAP Agreement #14B-5028 (Agenda 3-6) established funding year 2014. Amendment #1 (Agenda 3-8) increased the maximum amount of the agreement. Amendment #2 increases the maximum amount of the agreement in the amount of \$1,641,932.
