## BACKGROUND:

### <u>Summary</u>

The Department of Mental Health (DMH) operates a continuum of care system, composed of County-operated and contract service providers, delivering twenty four (24) hour treatment in each geographic region of the County. These providers, listed in Attachment A, are licensed by the State of California as Skilled Nursing Facilities (SNFs), and include a Special Treatment Program (STP) certified by the State Department of Mental Health. In addition to providing medical services, these programs provide intensive psychiatric treatment for DMH clients at a level of care which is lower than that of State Hospitals or the county's Inpatient Treatment Facility (ITF).

On June 25, 2013 (agenda item 3.20), the Board of Supervisors approved contract service agreements, in the aggregate amount of \$9,195,662. On June 3, 2014 (agenda item 3-59), the Board approved an additional agreement and increased the aggregate amount to \$10,427,794.

#### Impact on Citizens and Businesses

These services are a component of the Department's system of care aimed at improving the health and safety of consumers and the community.

# Additional Fiscal Information

The Agreements, outlined in Attachment A, are funded through realignment and include termination clauses, in the event applicable Federal, State and/or County funds become unavailable for the provision of services. There are sufficient funds in the department's FY 14/15 budget and no additional County funds are required.

# **Contract History and Price Reasonableness**

These contracts are scheduled for re-bid in FY 15/16. SNF rates were negotiated based on a combination of State established and County maximum allowable rates. The Department is requesting approval of these vendors in the interim to avoid interruption of services and ensure continuity of care for consumers.
