### **BACKGROUND:**

#### **Summary**

By Minute Order dated March 11, 2014 (Agenda Item 3-41), the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of the Washington Street and Krameria Avenue Traffic Signal and Lighting, Washington Street Resurfacing and King Avenue Sidewalk Projects in the Community of Woodcrest.

During the advertisement period, one addendum was issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders are required to acknowledge and take into account all issued addenda on their Contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award. The addendum was issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addendum is attached and designated as Addendum No. 1.

Six bids were received on April 2, 2014, ranging from \$924,531 to \$1,096,784. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by R-JS General Construction, Inc. (R-JS) in the amount of \$924,531, which is \$125,469 (12%) less than the Engineer's Estimate.

One bid, from CLS Constructors, Inc. (not the low bidder), was determined to be non-responsive and rejected due to the submission of an incomplete bid package.

A Letter of Bid Protest was submitted by the second low bidder for this project. The letter argued that: 1) The Bid Bond was not properly filled in and that R-JS failed to provide a properly executed Power of Attorney, 2) R-JS is neither qualified nor capable to self-perform certain construction tasks, and 3) R-JS qualifications are questionable to complete the scope of work within the assigned project working days and that the apparent low bidder should be declared as non-responsive and not responsible.

The Transportation Department (Department) and County Counsel reviewed the protest. Regarding the Bid Bond and Power of Attorney documents, it was determined that while the bid documents contained a minor reference error between two documents, the two documents are identified with an accurate job description; thus, this clerical error could be waived. Both of these documents were executed properly. Regarding the qualifications of R-JS, Department staff met with the apparent low bidder as part of the Department's evaluation of the contractor's qualifications, AC paving knowledge, company assets, estimated cost parameters, and experience related to this project's type of work. After the qualifications discussion meeting with contractor staff and obtaining additional staff, financial, and experience information, R-JS is considered a "responsible" bidder.

The bid protester was notified that the County of Riverside (County) determined the apparent low bidder to be responsive and responsible. The bid protester stated they would not further proceed with their initial protest. Attached is a letter dated April 30, 2014, sent by the Department responding to the second low bidder's letter (also included as one of the attachment).

Reasonable care has been taken during the design phase to determine the location of underground utilities, including research of information from the local utility providers and communication with the utility owners. Given the uncertainties associated with performing undergrounding work, there is a potential for additional costs during construction to locate conflicting utilities by pot-holing and excavating and to make field construction changes as needed to avoid utilities. A contingency has been included in the construction budget, to be utilized only if deemed necessary by the Department, to cover the costs of resolving utility conflicts.

The construction duration set for this project is for 40 working days, and construction is anticipated to be completed during the summer of 2014.

The contractor has executed the contract and provided bonds documents, which meet the requirements of the Contract.

Project No. C1-0498, C2-0129, and C3-0089

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

The proposed improvements will improve traffic operations, provide access ramps compliant with the Americans with Disability Act (ADA), and improve roadway safety for pedestrians, students, and motorists.

The new road surface will extend the life of the road by at least 15 years.

**Additional Fiscal Information**

The contract is recommended to be awarded to R-JS for the total amount of \$924,531. The project is funded with Proposition 1B (State Bond Funds – Local Streets and Roads), Gas Tax (New HUTA), West County DIF Signal Mitigation Fund, and SB-821 (Local Transportation Funds), for which the County successfully competed and obtained. There are no General Funds used for these projects.

Annual maintenance cost for the traffic signal is estimated to be \$5,500.

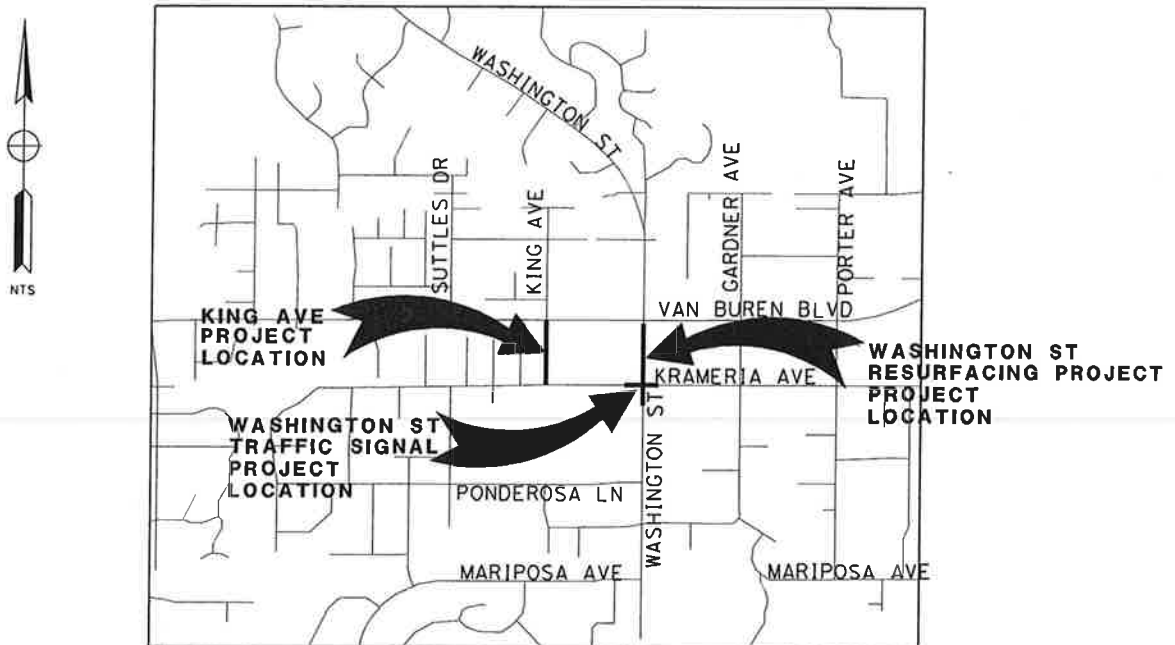
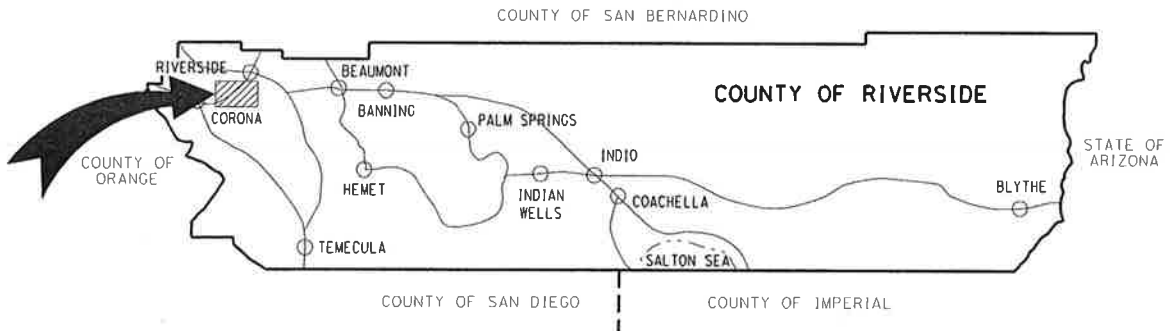
