BACKGROUND CONTINUED:

- 1. Hemet Community Pantry- \$5,554.04** funding will be used to purchase food supplies for homebound seniors and disabled residents and utility assistance.
- 2. Michelle's Place, Breast Cancer Resource Center- \$5,000-** funding will be used to further assist uninsured women who have a symptom of breast cancer with free diagnostic breast health services through the Breast Health Assistance program. Through this program, women who qualify will receive navigation through the medical process, evaluation, facilitation of diagnostic services, follow-up care and support.
- 3. The Boys and Girls Club of Southwest County (BGCSWC)- \$5,000-** funds will be allocated to provide daily after-school academic tutoring and support to low-income at risk youth through the Boys and Girls Clubs, Project LEARN tutoring program. The program is provided at three BGCSWC clubhouses (Lake Elsinore, Murrieta, Temecula) each day includes mandatory tutoring for homework completion and academic improvement.
