RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Approve the use of Community Improvement Designation funds to provide \$500 scholarships to 14 High School Seniors within the First District who plan on attending a California Community College or Career or Technical Education Program within Riverside County.
- 2) Approve and direct the Auditor-Controller to make the following budget adjustments:

21100-1900500000-551100 Contributions to Other County Funds \$7,000

Decrease Board Designation:

21100-1900500000-330100 Committed Fund Balance \$7,000

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation Funds, being held in an EDA fund for 1st District programs designed to assist Youth & Seniors, will be allocated to twelve 2014 High School Graduates, who are recipients of a First District \$500 Scholarship.

1. The First District worked with the principals and counselors of all the high schools in District 1. Two (2) students (one male and one female) were eligible from each school to be nominated to receive a \$500 scholarship to assist with tuition.
2. The Award guidelines are as follows:
 - a. Recipient must plan on attending a California Community College OR eligible trade school within Riverside County
 - b. If attending a community college, student must be pursuing one of the Career and Technical Education programs (Degree/Certificate)
 - c. Only trade schools within Riverside County that are currently eligible to receive Cal Grant Funding will be eligible for this award (This link will provides a list of eligible schools: http://www.csac.ca.gov/pubs/forms/grnt_frm/eligible_cal_grant_schools.pdf)
 - d. Students must provide proof of acceptance and/or enrollment verification
 - e. The scholarship will be sent directly to the Financial Aid Office of the student's indicated college/trade school (students will NOT receive a check personally). If the student decides not to attend the indicated college/trade school, the money will be forfeited.
3. 14 students from 22 High Schools were nominated and meet the criteria for a scholarship award. See attached document for names and schools for nominees.
