BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Housing Authority of the County of Riverside (HACR) operates housing programs outlined in the attached Annual Budget Booklet for Fiscal Year 2014-2015, funded primarily by multi-year contracts with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). These programs benefit low and moderate income individuals in Riverside County. All costs of operating these programs are offset principally by revenues from Federal, State, and local governments and agencies, pursuant to governmental cost accounting guidelines. Various contracts with HUD, ranging from one to fifteen year durations, provide for an administrative fee earned by the HACR for the development, rehabilitation, lease and maintenance of affordable housing.

The HACR's FY 2014-2015 Budget also includes funds from the Low and Moderate Income Housing Asset Fund, bond proceeds, and an administrative cost allowance needed to perform all activities as the successor to the housing functions for the former Redevelopment Agency for the County of Riverside and for the former Coachella Redevelopment Agency.

County Counsel has reviewed and approved the Fiscal Year 2014-2015 Annual Budget and Resolution No. 2014-008 as to form. Staff recommends approval.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Adoption of the FY 2014-2015 Annual Budget will enable the HACR to continue with its mission of providing project and tenant based rental assistance, short term rental/utility assistance, housing information service, and housing case management services to low and moderate-income households, veterans, and chronically homeless individuals.
