BACKGROUND: Summary (continued)

APPENDIX B COACHELLA VALLEY CONSERVATION COMMISSION

CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES

CATEGORY 1

Filers in this category shall disclose the following:

- a) Investments, business positions in business entities and sources of income, including gifts, loans and travel payments.
- b) Interests in real property located in the jurisdiction.

CATEGORY 2

Filers in this category shall disclose the following:

a) Investments, business positions in business entities and income, including gifts, loans, and travel payments from sources that provide leased facilities, goods, equipment, or services including consulting services of the type utilized by the Agency.
