1) Approve the use of Community Improvement Designation funds for:



BACKGROUND: CONTINUED

- 1. Food for the Faithful - \$2,500-** provides food on a bi-monthly basis for 150-200 Anza Valley families. In addition, they provide energy and rental assistance for families in need of these services.
- 2. Murrieta Mesa Music Boosters - \$1,000.-** provide the performers with skills and team building leadership, consistent with what independent teams, colleges and employers are looking for. Specifically, funding allocated will allow students an opportunity to compete at the Marching Band Open Series located at Silverado High School in Las Vegas, Nevada.
- 3. Riverside National Cemetery Support Committee- \$2,500-** Support for the Riverside National Cemetery, Concert for Heroes for musicians, staging, and the sound system associated with the concert.
- 4. My City Life Youth- \$2,000-** This program provides physical and spiritual needs of at risk and under resourced youth by directing them away from idle street involvement, engaging them in a safe and healthy activities at the My City Life Youth Center. Funding will be used to improve the recreation room with televisions.
- 5. Community Food Pantry of Murrieta - \$5,000** the funds will be used to purchase emergency food, personal hygiene products, diapers, and gas cards so that clients can get to and from the pantry and doctors' appointments.
