SUBJECT: Approval of Lanterman-Petris-Short (LPS) Act (5150) Designation of Riverside County Telecare Psychiatric Health Facility (PHF) and Crisis Stabilization Unit (CSU) for Involuntary Detention of Mentally Disordered Persons for Evaluation and Treatment. (District 4) [\$0]

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Designate Riverside County Telecare, a 16 bed PHF and 12 bed CSU facility, located at 47-915 Oasis Street, Indio, CA 92201, as a facility for 72 hour evaluation and treatment pursuant to California Welfare and Institutions (W&I) Code, Section 5150 et. Seq.; and
2. Designate the CSU as a 12 bed facility for 72 hour evaluation and treatment of minors pursuant to California W&I Code, Section 5585 et. Seq.; and
3. Authorize the Director of Mental Health to submit the LPS designation request to the State Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) as required by Section 800 et. Seq., Title 9, California Code of Regulations.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

On June 3, 2014 (3-59), the Board of Supervisors approved the Agreement with Telecare Corporation for the provision of PHF and CSU mental health services. In accordance with their Agreement with the Department of Mental Health (DMH), Telecare is seeking State licensure and LPS designation to provide acute mental health services for individuals involuntarily detained under California W&I Code Section 5150. Additionally, in accordance with California W&I Code Section 5585, the CSU will provide prompt evaluation and treatment of mentally disordered minors, with particular priority given to seriously emotionally disturbed children and adolescents. Board approval is required to designate Telecare Corporation to operate the facility as a LPS (5150) 72 hour treatment and evaluation site of adults and minors, and to authorize the Director of Mental Health to submit the LPS designation request to the State DHCS.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The LPS designation of Riverside County Telecare PHF and CSU will provide Riverside County constituents with continued access to a facility to serve individuals that have been placed on a 5150 involuntary detention for evaluation and treatment. There is no other LPS designated facility in the eastern region of Riverside County. These services are a component of the Department's system of care aimed at improving the health and safety of consumers and the community.
