BACKGROUND: CONTINUED:

- 1. United States Veteran Initiative (US Vets) - \$7,500.00** This donation to U.S. Vets will be used to sponsor the Riverside County Veterans Stand Down which will be held at the Perris Fairgrounds on October 17, 2014. The Stand Down is one of the many measureable outcomes of the Riverside County VALOR Initiative, whose goal is to end homelessness among veterans in Riverside County by 2015. In addition to sponsoring the Stand Down, a portion of the funds will be used to generate several openings in the U.S. Vets program where veterans and their families can receive housing, case management, job training and other wrap around services to improve their lives and end the cycle of homelessness.
- 2. Voices of Inland Communities for Education- \$500-** provides educational, health and safety needs of the inland communities children. The funds will support the "Santa Comes to Our Valley Program" holiday program that gives toys and gifts for low-income families children.
