SUBJECT: Approval of Election Services and Consolidation of Elections, All Districts, [\$4,500,000].

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the Registrar of Voters to conduct the Consolidated General Election on November 4, 2014 pursuant to the proclamation of Governor Brown;
2. Approve that election services for local jurisdictions be consolidated with the November 4, 2014 Consolidated General Election.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

California Elections Code §§ 10002, 10402, and 10403 allow jurisdictions to request that the Board of Supervisors approve the Registrar of Voters to conduct and consolidate elections by submitting a resolution requesting these services. The attached Exhibit A listed jurisdictions have requested the Registrar of Voters to conduct and consolidate their elections. The Registrar of Voters has the resources to provide these services. The County will not be reimbursed for the federal and state office elections but the Registrar of Voters will receive reimbursements from local jurisdictions for the full cost of conducting their election.
