BACKGROUND: Summary

The District Attorney's Office, on behalf of the County, will apply for new grant funding to support enhanced comprehensive services to human trafficking victims via the Human Trafficking Advocacy (HA) Program. The HA Program is supported with Victims of Crime Act Funds and provides funding for projects that provide services to human trafficking victims, but need additional staff and support to identify and provide comprehensive services to those victims.

Any resulting grant award will be brought back to the Board for acceptance along with any necessary budget adjustments.

The Certification of Assurance of Compliance form has been reviewed and approved as to form by County Counsel.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

All costs for this program will be recovered through grant funding.

CERTIFICATION OF ASSURANCE OF COMPLIANCE Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) Fund

The applicant must complete a Certification of Assurance of Compliance-VOCA (Cal OES 2-104f), which includes details regarding Federal Grant Funds, Equal Employment Opportunity Program (EEOP), Drug Free Workplace Compliance, California Environmental Quality Act, Lobbying, Debarment and Suspension requirements, Proof of Authority from City Council/Governing Board, and the special conditions under the Victims of Crime Act (VOCA). The applicant is required to submit the necessary assurances and documentation before finalization of the Grant Award Agreement. VIII. Special Condition for Grant Awards with Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) Fund

 The grant recipient agrees to administer the grant in accordance with the VOCA, the VOCA Program Guidelines, and the Office of Justice Programs Financial Guide. All appropriate documentation must be maintained on file by the project and available for Cal OES or public scrutiny upon request. Failure to comply with these requirements may result in suspension of payments under the grant or termination of the grant or both and the Recipient may be ineligible for award of any future grants if the Cal OES determines that any of the following has occurred: (1) the Recipient has made false certification, or (2) violates the certification by failing to carry out the requirements as noted above.
