BACKGROUND: Summary (continued)

The Treasurer-Tax Collector has received one claim for excess proceeds:

1. Claim from Eastern Municipal Water District based on a Notice of Intent to Remove Delinquent Assessment Installments from Tax Roll recorded on September 29, 2008 as Instrument No. 2008-0528080.

Pursuant to Section 4675 (a) & (e) of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, it is the recommendation of this office that Eastern Municipal Water District be denied since the balance of the outstanding debt has been paid in full. Since there are no other claimants the excess proceeds in the amount of \$17,536.22 will remain unclaimed. Supporting documentation has been provided. The Tax Collector requests approval of the above recommended motion. Notice of this recommendation was sent to the claimant by certified mail.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

Excess proceeds are being denied to the lien holder of the property and Pursuant to Section 4673.1 (2) of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, since there were no other claimants the remaining unclaimed excess proceeds are being transferred to the Auditor's office for apportionment.

Pursuant to Section 4673.1 (2) of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, the remaining balance of the proceeds to be distributed under this section shall be distributed to each tax fund in an amount bearing the same proportion to the balance remaining as the tax rate for each fund bears to the total tax rate applicable to the property for the fiscal year preceding that in which the property was sold.
