FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS AND ORDER TO ABATE NUISANCE

R.C.O. Nos. 348, 541 and 725

The above-captioned matter came on regularly for hearing on August 5, 2014, before the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California in the Board Room, First Floor Annex, County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California regarding the real property described as Vacant Lot on Baldwin Ave., Lakeland Village, Riverside County, Assessor's Parcel Number 381-245-014 and referred to hereinafter as "THE PROPERTY."

Patricia Munroe, Deputy County Counsel, appeared along with Michelle Cervantes, Senior Code Enforcement Officer, on behalf of the Director of the Code Enforcement Department.

Owner did not appear.

The Board of Supervisors received the Declaration of the Code Enforcement Officer together with attached Exhibits, evidencing the excessive outside storage of materials and accumulation of rubbish on THE PROPERTY as violations of Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 348 and 541 and as a public nuisance.

SUMMARY OF EVIDENCE

- 1. Documents of record in the Riverside County Recorder's Office identify the owner of THE PROPERTY as Estate of Byron E. Wright ("OWNER").
- 2. Documents of title indicate that another party may potentially hold a legal interest in THE PROPERTY, to wit: Brad Bielec and Michael Crosby (hereinafter referred to as "INTERESTED PARTIES").
- 3. THE PROPERTY was inspected by Code Enforcement Officers on June 2, 2011, April 6, 2012, and on 16 other subsequent inspections, the last occurred on June 4, 2014.
- 4. During each inspection an accumulation of rubbish and excess outside storage was observed throughout THE PROPERTY consisting of but not limited to: household trash, debris, boxes, over 25 tires, furniture, shelving, pipes, wood, plastic storage totes, and miscellaneous items in excess of 1,100 square feet.
- 5. THE PROPERTY was determined to be in violation of Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 348 and 541 by the Code Enforcement Officer.
- 6. On August 13, 2012, a Notice of Pendency of Administrative Proceedings was recorded at the Riverside County Recorder's Office as instrument number 2012-0383913.
- 7. On June 2, 2011 and April 15, 2014, a Notice of Violation was posted on THE PROPERTY. On June 6, 2011 and September 26, 2012, a Notice of Violation was mailed to OWNER by first class mail. On April 15, 2014, a Notice of Violation was mailed to OWNER and INTERESTED PARTIES by certified mail with return receipt requested. On May 19, 2014, a Notice of Violation was mailed to INTERESTED PARTIES.
- 8. A "Notice to Correct County Ordinance Violations and Abate Public Nuisance" providing notice of the public hearing before the Board of Supervisors was mailed to OWNER and INTERESTED PARTIES on July 1, 2014, and was posted on THE PROPERTY on July 2, 2014.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

WHEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on August 5, 2014, finds and concludes that:

1. WHEREAS, the excessive outside storage of materials and accumulation of rubbish

on the real property located at Vacant Lot on Baldwin Ave., Lakeland Village, Riverside County, California, also identified as Assessor's Parcel Number 381-245-014 violates Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 348 and 541 and constitutes a public nuisance.

- WHEREAS, the OWNER, INTERESTED PARTIES, occupants and any other person 2. having possession or control of THE PROPERTY shall abate the accumulation of rubbish and excessive outside storage of materials by removing and disposing of all rubbish and excessive outside storage on THE PROPERTY in strict accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not limited to Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 348 and 541 within ninety (90) days.
- WHEREAS, the OWNER and INTERESTED PARTIES ARE HEREBY FURTHER 3. NOTICED that the time within which judicial review of the administrative determinations made herein must be sought is ninety (90) days from the posting and mailing of the Findings of Fact, Conclusions and Order To Abate Nuisance, and is governed by California Code of Civil Procedure Section 1094.6.

ORDER TO ABATE NUISANCE

IT IS ORDERED that the accumulation of rubbish and excessive outside storage of materials on THE PROPERTY be abated by OWNER, INTERESTED PARTIES, or anyone having possession or control of THE PROPERTY by removing and disposing of all rubbish and excessive outside storage of materials on THE PROPERTY (including, but not limited to household trash, debris, boxes, over 25 tires, furniture, shelving, pipes, wood, plastic storage totes, and miscellaneous items in excess of 1,100 square feet) in strict accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not limited to Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 348 and 541, within ninety (90) days of the posting and mailing of this Order to Abate Nuisance.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the accumulation of rubbish and excessive outside storage of materials is not removed and disposed of in strict accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not limited to Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 348 and 541 within ninety (90) days of the date of this Order to Abate Nuisance, the accumulation of rubbish and excessive outside storage of materials may be abated and disposed of by representatives of the Riverside County Code Enforcement Department, a contractor or the Sheriff's Department upon receipt of an owner's consent or a Court Order when necessary under applicable law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that reasonable abatement costs, after notice and opportunity for hearing, shall be imposed as a lien on THE PROPERTY, which may be collected as a special assessment against THE PROPERTY pursuant to Government Code section 25845 and Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 348, 541, and 725. Under Riverside County Ordinance No. 725, "abatement costs" means any costs or expenses, including County staff time reasonably related to the abatement of conditions which violate Land Use Ordinances, and shall include, but not be limited to, enforcement, investigation, summaries, reports, notices, telephonic contact, correspondence, mailing expense, title search costs, administrative costs including scheduling and participation at hearings, Hearing Officer costs, expenses incurred by the County, court costs, civil or administrative penalties, collection, attorneys' fees, and other costs associated with the removal, abatement or correction of a
