BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

Based upon the results of the E&TS for these roads, the radar-enforceable speed limits recommended by the Transportation Department are summarized in the attached tables and have been determined to be appropriate to facilitate the safe and orderly movement of vehicular traffic.

Transportation Department staff has informed the Riverside, Temecula, San Geronio, and Indio area offices of the California Highway Patrol (CHP) of the recommended speed zones.

The Ordinance amendment has been reviewed and approved by County Counsel as to form.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The establishing and posting of appropriate speed limits promotes safe and orderly movements of vehicular traffic and enable the CHP to use radar equipment to enforce the speed limits. Since the recommended speed limits were determined based on actual speed surveys, the majority of the motorists are already driving at or below the recommended speed limits. Posted speed limits also guide motorists to drive at a reasonable speed in unfamiliar locations.

SUPPLEMENTAL

Additional Fiscal Information

The cost for establishing the recommended speed limits is primarily for the installation of speed limit signs, which is estimated at about \$4,000.

1 Section 5. Section 2.7 of Ordinance 452, entitled “Fifty-five miles per hour,” is hereby
2 amended to add new subsection 27 to read as follows:

3 “27. On Domenigoni Parkway between a point 1,900 feet west of Leon
4 Road to a point 1 mile west of Leon Road, a total distance of
5 approximately 0.64 mile.”

6 Section 6. Subsection 14 of Section 2.7 of Ordinance 452 adopted on September 16,
7 2008, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.224, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 14 of Section 2.7
8 established a fifty-five miles per hour speed limit on Domenigoni Parkway from Menifee Road to a point
9 1,900 feet west of Leon Road.

10 Section 7. Subsection 117 of Section 2.3 of Ordinance 452 adopted on August 20,
11 2013 , pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.234, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 117 of Section 2.3
12 established a thirty-five miles per hour speed limit on Briggs Road between Barn Road and Thorens
13 Road.

14 Section 8. Subsection 163 of Section 2.5 of Ordinance 452 adopted on April 22, 2014,
15 pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.236, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 163 of Section 2.5 established a
16 forty-five miles per hour speed limit on Orchard Street between Beaumont Avenue and Noble Street.

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Section 9. This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its adoption.
