#### **RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Find that the acceptance of portions of Watson Road in the Homeland area is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Sections 15060(c)(2) and 15061(b)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines; and
- 2. Adopt Resolution No. 2014-049, Accepting Portions of Watson Road in the Homeland Area; and
- 3. Direct the Clerk of the Board to deliver the Notice of Exemption to the Office of the County Clerk for filing within five (5) working days of this Board hearing.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

#### Summary

The Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (Flood Control) has requested the acceptance of portions of Watson Road for the purpose of constructing a new storm drain within the right-of-way by encroachment permit. Flood Control has notified all property owners of the proposed improvements. As determined in the attached Notice of Exemption, the Project is exempt from the provisions of CEQA pursuant to Categorical Exemptions 15060 (c)(2) and 15061(b)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines. The Acceptance will not result in any specific or general exceptions to the use of the categorical exemption and will not cause any direct or indirect physical environmental impacts.

# IN THE HOMELAND AREA

(Third Supervisorial District)

**WHEREAS**, the hereinafter-described road was offered for dedication for road and public utility purposes on the maps hereinafter-referred to, which said offers of dedication have not been previously accepted for public use by the County of Riverside; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on \_\_\_\_\_\_, 2014, that this Board accepts said offers of dedication and recognizes that this road is a public road open for use by the general public.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED that this acceptance is for the purpose of vesting title in the County of Riverside on behalf of the public for public road and utility uses, and is not an acceptance of the road into the County Maintained Road System pursuant to Section 941 of the Streets and Highways Code and that said road will not become part of the County Maintained Road System unless subsequently accepted into said Maintained Road System by a resolution adopted by this Board.


Said road is in the County of Riverside, State of California, and described as follows:

# Watson Road (See Exhibit "A")

That portion of Watson Road (88.00 feet wide) shown as Lot "C" on Parcel Map 7736, filed in Book 28, Pages 6 and 7, of Parcel Maps, records of Riverside County, California, and that portion of Watson Road (44.00 feet southerly half-width) shown as Lots "C" and "D" on Parcel Map 11339, filed in Book 99, Page 6, of Parcel Maps, records of Riverside County, California, and that portion of Watson Road (44.00 feet southerly half-width) shown on Parcel Map No. 9021, filed in Book 40, Pages 13 through 15, inclusive, of Parcel Maps, records of Riverside County, California.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED** that the Clerk of the Board is directed to cause a certified copy of this resolution to be recorded in the office of the Recorder of the County of Riverside, California.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Riverside County Flood Control District has requested the acceptance of portions of Watson Road for the purpose of constructing a new storm drain within the right-of-way by an encroachment permit. The acceptance of the portions of Watson Road, shown on Exhibit "A", is for the purpose of vesting title in the County of Riverside on behalf of the public for public road and utility uses, and is not an acceptance of the road into the County Maintained Road Section, pursuant to Section 941 of the Streets and Highways Code. Therefore, these unimproved portions of Watson Road will not become part of the County Maintained Road System until the road is brought up to County Standard. Riverside County Flood Control District has notified all property owners of the proposed improvements.

The Riverside County Transportation Department Staff conducted a review of the above referenced project and has determined that the proposals qualify for a Categorical Exemption per the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines.
