BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Riverside Medical Clinic Charitable Foundation- \$1,000** funding will be used to provide training to educators, law enforcement, youth leaders, and community representatives who are committed to ending bullying.
2. **Martin Luther King High School, "King High Remembers" - \$1,500** funding will be used to provide assistance with costs with the King High Remembers program. A Veterans Oral History Project.
3. **Smiles for Seniors Foundation- \$1,000** to support their efforts of providing emergency assistance for food, housing and utility payments as well as home and auto repair, and help pay for life saving prescriptions, and medical equipment for senior citizens in the 1st District.
4. **United States Veterans Initiative - \$1,000** funding will be used to enhance employment & training opportunities for veterans who enter US VETS- Inland Empire site.
