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RECOMMENDED MOTION:

BACKGROUND:

Since 2005, CAP Riverside has coordinated with the IRS to open VITA sites throughout Riverside County. The IRS funding will support CAP Riverside's Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) Program by providing marketing/outreach materials, training for approximately 175 volunteer tax preparers and administrative support at 18 VITA sites.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The IRS estimates the 25% of California eligible EITC funds go unclaimed each year. EITC is recognized nationally as one of the most effective means to move low-income people out of poverty. Since 2005, CAP Riverside's volunteer tax preparers have completed over 20,682 income tax returns, generating over \$27.2 million in tax refunds for low-income residents of Riverside County. CAP Riverside anticipates completing 3,500 tax returns at no-cost for low-income Riverside County Residents for the 2014-2015 program year.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

No County General Funds would be required. \$67,000 was included in the budget for FY2014/2015. Budget adjustment for \$2,000 is included in Schedule A.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

On November 24, 2009 (#3.41), November 9, 2010 (#3.3), October 18, 2011 (#2.5), October 1, 2013 (#3.5) the Board of Supervisors approved each consecutive VITA grant application. This application provides \$69,000 in funding for VITA program.
