BACKGROUND:

DATE: October 9, 2014

Summary

The County Transportation Improvement Program provides for the resurfacing of Elm Street, between Adele Avenue and Bonita Avenue, and Main Street, between Seminole Drive and Railroad Avenue, in the Community of Cabazon.

The proposed resurfacing of the road will provide the public with a smooth, paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic and extend the service life of these roads.

The planned improvements include grinding existing pavement and overlaying with new hot mix asphalt concrete pavement. Shoulder backing material will be placed to protect the outside edge of pavement, prevent edge cracking, and pavement edge deterioration. Safety improvement items include striping, reflective pavement markers, roadside signs, AC Dike curb and gutter, and guard railing.

The plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel, and environmental clearance is complete.

Project Numbers: C1-0581 and C1-0583

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The proposed improvements will benefit the project area by significantly improving the existing infrastructure. preserving and extending the service life, as well as providing upgrades to enhance safety.

The work is scheduled to begin in early 2015. The work will be phased to keep the roads open during construction and will take approximately two months to complete.

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$857,375, and construction is expected to finish in FY 2014/2015. The project is funded with Proposition 1B (State Bond Funds-Local Roads).
