BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. Riverside County Mexican American Historical Society- \$1,000** funding will be used to assist in the efforts to share and the preservation of Hispanic Heritage history.
- 2. Riverside Proud Heritage Band & Color Guard Boosters - \$1,500** funds will be used to benefit underserved youth participating in the band and color guard programs at Poly High School to provide needed entry fees, props, uniforms, emergency supplies and instrument repairs. Due to the severe drought in California, their carwash fundraising efforts have been prohibited.
- 3. Community Outreach Ministry - \$500** funds will be used to benefit their Annual Angel Tree Christmas Project which provides food and clothing to 200+ at-risk and/or needy children (ages 0-18) whose parents are incarcerated, as well as provide them with a holiday meal on December 14th.
