BACKGROUND CONTINUED:

Summary

Pursuant to AB 2071, in 1996 the State Department of Alcohol and Drug Program (ADP) streamlined their Multi-Year Negotiated Net Amount (NNA)/Drug Medi-Cal Contract process. As a result of this streamlining effort, procedural changes were enacted and each county and direct contract services provider receives a multi-year contract Agreement every three (3) years based on the Governor's Preliminary Budget Act Allocation. Effective July 1, 2013, as a result of the passage of the 2013-2014 Budget Act and associated legislation, all ADP programs transferred to the DHCS.

On June 22, 2010 (3-27), the Riverside County Board of Supervisors approved the combined NNA/Drug Medi-Cal Agreement No. 10-NNA33 with ADP and adopted Resolution No. 2010-137. After the initial multi-year Agreement was executed, ADP issued Agreement Amendments that were approved through Board of Supervisor actions on March 13, 2012 (3-34), August 28, 2012 (3-71), September 10, 2013 (3-61), and July 1, 2014 (3-30).

The Riverside County Department of Mental Health, Substance Use Program received Standard Agreement 14-90085 for Substance Use Disorder Services for FY 2014/2015 through FY 2016/2017. This Agreement makes provisions for services to Non Medi-Cal and Medi-Cal consumers of Riverside County's Substance Use Programs. Medi-Cal and NNA services include: Prevention, Outpatient Drug Free (ODF), Narcotic Treatment Program (NTP), Day Care Rehabilitative (DCR), Detoxification, Perinatal, and Residential Services. Services are fully detailed in Exhibit A, Attachment I, Part V, Section 2 (Covered Services) of the Standard Agreement. This Agreement continues the implementation of AB118 which is funded by state sales tax as the dedicated revenue to support these programs. The Realignment of 2011 moved specific State Alcohol and Other Drug (AOD) programs to local governments to meet local community needs and priorities. The programs that were realigned were Women's and Children's Residential Treatment Services, Drug Court, Non-Drug Medi-Cal Perinatal, Non-Drug Medi-Cal Regular, and Drug Medi-Cal.

Furthermore, the Standard Agreement stipulates that it is enforceable only if sufficient funds are made available by the Federal and State governments, and pursuant to the States' Budget Act.

Period of Performance:

The period of performance for Standard Agreement No. 14-90085 for Substance Use Disorder Services is from July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2017.

Justification for Delay:

The DMH did not receive the Standard Agreement until October 20, 2014, and the process for bringing this Agreement to the Board of Supervisors was initiated immediately upon receipt.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

These services are a component of the Department's system of care aimed at improving the health and safety of consumers and the community.

Additional Fiscal Information:

The Agreement has termination clauses in the event that applicable funds become unavailable for service provision. There are sufficient funds in the DMH's FY 14/15 budget and no additional County funds are required.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Rates are set forth and regulated by the State.
