BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for the Landfill Road Resurfacing Project in the unincorporated area of Indio.

The road is classified as "rural collector" and used by the public accessing the landfill, local farms, and businesses. Various sections of road have moderate damage with some alligator cracking and block cracking caused by heavy wheel loads and thermal effects and are in need of repair.

The purpose of this project is to resurface the road to provide the public with a smooth, paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency for vehicular traffic.

The resurfacing work consists of grinding existing pavement and placing hot mix asphalt. Shoulder backing material will be placed to protect the outside edge of pavement and to prevent edge cracking and pavement edge deterioration. Safety improvement items include striping, reflective pavement markers, and the construction of a pavement "safety edge." The safety edge is engineered to enable drivers who drift off of the paved surface to return to the traveled surface safely.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel, and environmental clearance is complete.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The proposed improvements will benefit the public by improving the existing pavement and providing upgrades to enhance safety.

The work is scheduled to begin in early 2015. The work will be phased to keep the roads open during construction and will take approximately one to two months to complete.

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$710,000. Construction is expected to finish in FY 2014/2015 and will be funded with Measure A-Coachella Valley Funds.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

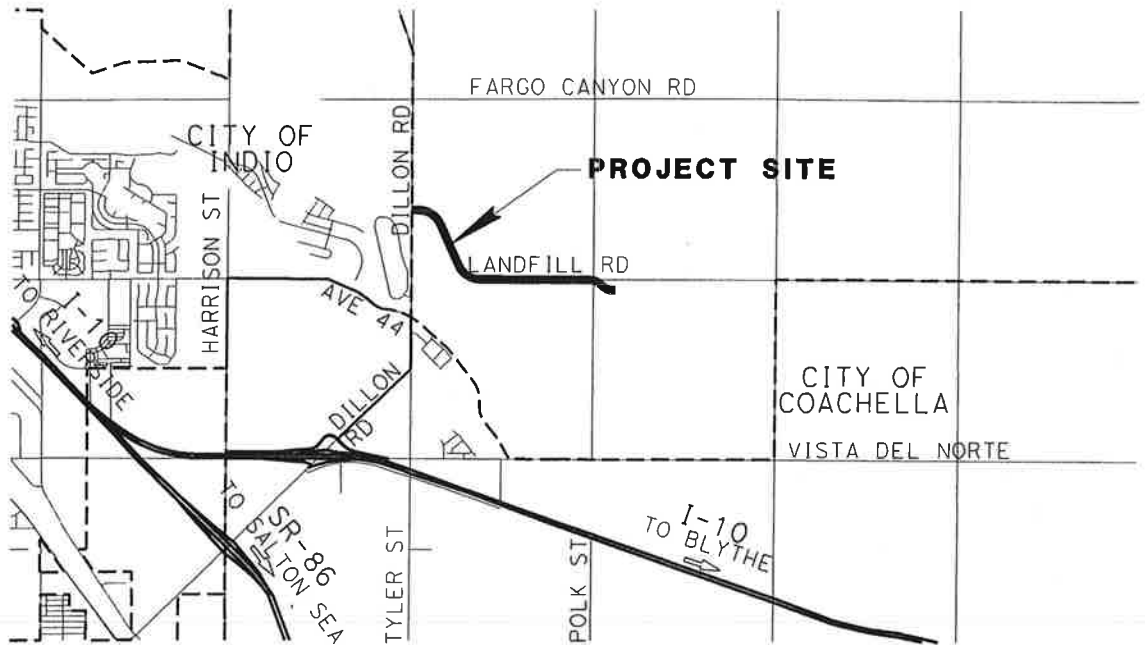
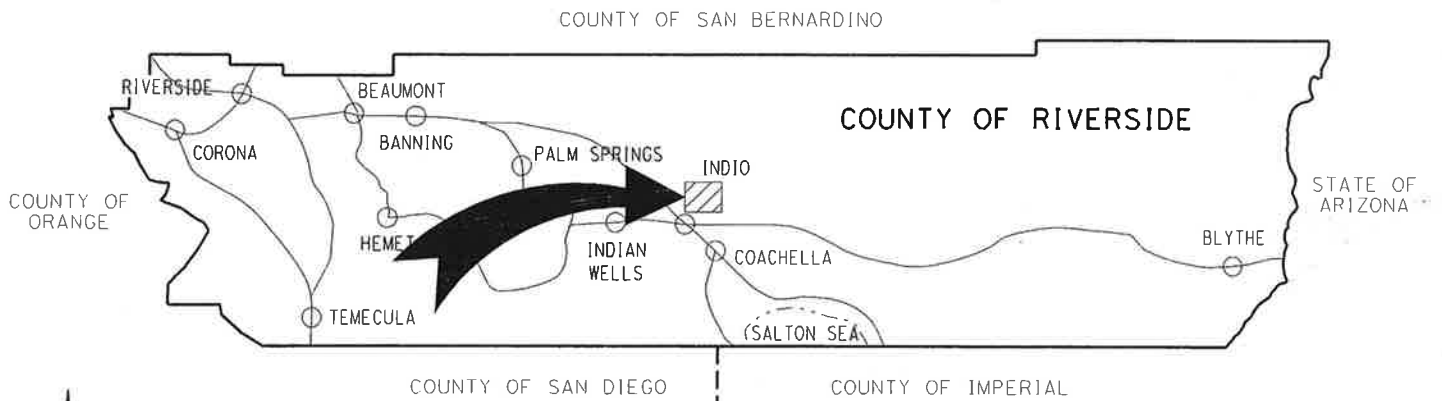
