**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Wildomar Rotary Club Foundation - \$500** funding will be used to assist the Rotary's effort to provide a bicycle safety event within the Wildomar community.
2. **Women Wonder Writers - \$1,000** funding will be used to assist with "BREAK Teen Trafficking", a community event in the 1<sup>st</sup> District dedicated to educating the youth and the community on teen trafficking.
3. **League of United Latin American Citizens LULAC of Riverside Council #3190 - \$2,000** funds will be used to assist the 4th Annual Free Community Health Fair. At this event, located in the 1<sup>st</sup> District, participants will receive free dental, vision and medical services. Up to 1,500 participants are expected to attend.
4. **Asian Pacific Cultural Association \$1,000** funding will be used to support one of the signature events in Riverside-- the annual cultural festival celebrating the Asian Pacific American cultures. This event is free and open to the public.
