1. That the Board of Supervisors approve and adopt Resolution No. 2015-020 declaring the County's intent to reimburse prior expenditures with proceeds of indebtedness.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Executive Office recommends that the Board of Supervisors adopt Resolution No. 2015-020 declaring its intent to reimburse itself from the proceeds of future bonds for capital project costs paid. This declaration is made solely for purposes of establishing compliance with the requirements of Section 1.150-2 of the Treasury Regulations. This declaration does not bind the County to make any expenditure, incur any indebtedness, or proceed with the project.

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BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

The Primary EOC, currently located in the County Administration Center basement, is being relocated in an effort to modernize the facility, provide adequate emergency vehicle staging, and act as an alternate Fire and Law Dispatch and Training Center. This project is included in the Capital Improvement Plan, recently approved on November 24, 2014.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The relocation of the Primary EOC will ensure a continuity of service in the event of an emergency.

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RESOLUTION NO. 2015-020 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE DECLARING ITS

INTENT TO ISSUE TAX-EXEMPT BONDS TO BE USED TO REIMBURSE THE COUNTY FOR EXPENDITURES

PRIOR TO THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS

WHEREAS, the County of Riverside (the "County") desires and intends to participate in financing the acquisition, construction, improvement, and equipping of buildings to be used as the Primary Emergency Operation Center project located within the County in furtherance of its municipal purposes (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the County expects to cause the issuance, delivery and sale of tax exempt obligations such as bonds, in one or more series, for the purpose of providing financing for a portion of the Project (the "Obligations"); and

WHEREAS, the County expects to incur certain expenditures relating to the Project an to pay for such expenditures from the County's moneys on hand prior to the execution of the Obligations (the "Reimbursement Expenditures"); and

WHEREAS, the County reasonably expects to use a portion of the proceeds of the Obligations to reimburse the County for expenditures made prior to the date the Obligations are issued;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, in regular session assembled on January 6, 2015, at 9:00 a.m., in its meeting room located on the 1st Floor of the County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California, as follows:

Section 1. Declaration of Official Intent. The County hereby declares its official intent, subject to the further approval of this Board, to use up to \$17,000,000 of the proceeds of the Obligations to reimburse itself for the Reimbursement Expenditures. It is intended that this Resolution shall constitute a declaration of "official intent" within the meaning of Section 1.150-2 of the Treasury Regulations promulgated under Section 150 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

1	Section 2. Other Approvals. The adoption of this Resolution shall not
2	bind the County to proceed with issuance of the Obligations until and unless all other
3	necessary actions and approvals are taken or received in accordance with all applicable laws.
4	Section 3. <u>Effective Date</u> . This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
