BACKGROUND:

Summary

On October 2, 2014, the Mayor of Jurupa Valley approved the execution of the city's first amendment to its law enforcement services Agreement with the County Sheriff's Department. This amendment modifies the level of law enforcement service provided by the Sheriff's Department with the addition of four Deputy Sheriff positions to fulfill the duties of traffic enforcement officers.

Sheriff's staff has recommended budget adjustments that correspond with the positions starting in pay period 2 of calendar year 2015. Staff is recommending these budget adjustments now, as it could not anticipate the expenditures and include them in its FY 2014-15 budget. All costs for this service will be fully recovered through Board-approved rates. County Counsel has approved the Amendment as to form.

The annual cost of this service improvement for the remaining four years of Jurupa Valley's agreement with the Sheriff's Department is detailed below:

FY 14/15 \$ 557,000 FY 15/16 \$1,188,000 FY 16/17 \$1,247,000 FY 17/18 \$1,310,000 Total Cost: \$4,302,000

Sheriff's staff has estimated a seven percent annual increase in the first two years to offset salary and benefit increases along with increasing PSEC radio costs. The remaining two years are estimated to have a five percent annual increase to offset salary and benefit increases only.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

This is an amendment to the agreement with the Sheriff's Department for law enforcement services, which the Jurupa Valley City Council approved and executed on behalf of its citizens. In addition, the city is replacing four of six Patrol Deputies that it deleted in August 2012. All costs for this service will be fully recovered through Board-approved rates.
