BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County Transportation Department proposes to improve 4.7 miles of Grand Avenue, between Corydon Road and Bonnie Lee Drive, in the community of Lakeland Village. The project consists of resurfacing the existing pavement, minor road widening, and reconstruction and construction of concrete curb, gutter, cross gutter, spandrel, sidewalk, and access ramps. Traffic improvements include new striping and pavement markings, new larger street name signs, and other work as may be required.

The bid documents include the following four bid schedules of work:

Base Bid: (Street Improvements)

Alternate Bid Schedule 1: (City of Lake Elsinore-Street Improvement)

Alternate Bid Schedule 2: (City of Wildomar-Street Improvement)

Alternate Bid Schedule 3: (Utility Adjustment work)

The street improvement work specified in Alternate Bid Schedules 1 and 2, if approved and concurred by the City of Lake Elsinore and the City of Wildomar as bid by the apparent low bidder, would be funded by the cities through a reimbursement agreement to be approved by the Board of Supervisors prior to or concurrent with the award of the construction contract.

Alternate Bid Schedule 3, if approved and concurred by utility companies as bid by the apparent low bidder, will be funded by the utility owners.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel, and environmental clearance is complete.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The proposed improvements will benefit the project area by significantly improving the existing infrastructure of the pavement, minor road widening for safer right turns, preserving and extending the service life, as well as providing upgrades to enhance pedestrian safety.

The work is scheduled to begin in early 2015. The work will be phased to keep the roads open during construction and will take approximately three months to complete.

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$3,705,000, and construction is expected to finish in FY 2014/2015 and will be funded with Redevelopment Agency Funds.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

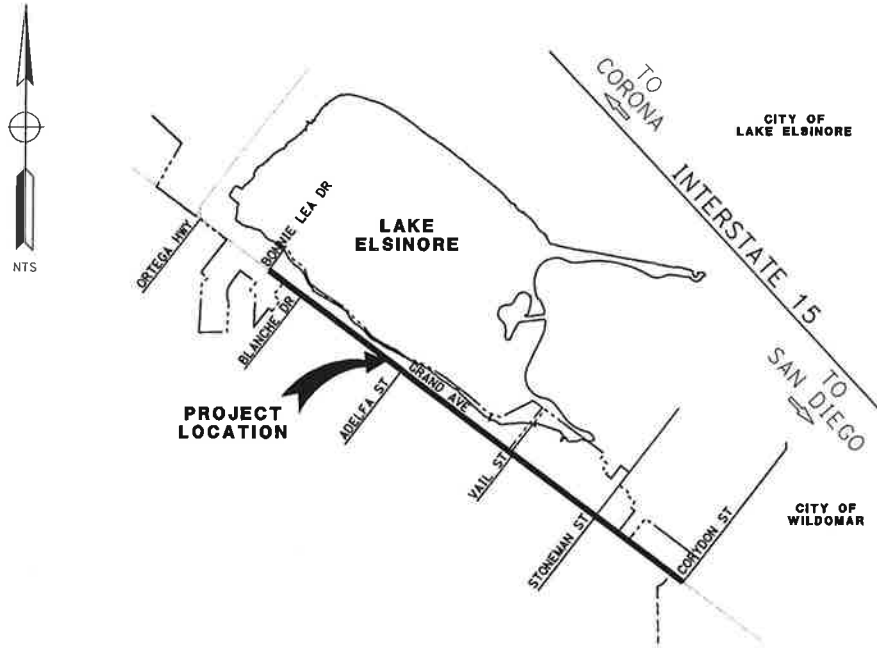
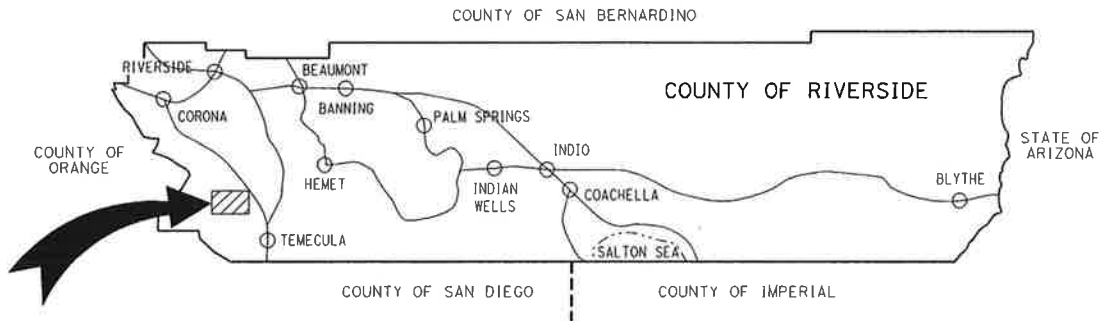
