BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. Riverside National Cemetery Support Committee- \$2,500 funding will be used to assist the Concert for Heroes at the Riverside National Cemetery. This event is free and open to the public.
- 2. A Salute to Veterans Parade Committee \$2,000 funding will be used to help fund this parade which honors veterans of all ages and all eras in the City of Riverside. Over 5,000 participants are expected to attend.
- 3. True Innocents Equine Rescue \$1,500 funds will be used to assist in improvements to the facility of the Rescue. The Rescue provides a home and treatment to neglected, abused, or abandoned horses in Western Riverside County.
- 4. Arlington High School Choirs \$1,500 funding will be used to help support disadvantaged students of the Arlington High Choir to perform with their peers at Carnegie Hall in New York.
- **5. Girl Scouts of San Gorgonio Council \$1,500** funds will be used to assist 30 5th and 6th grade girls in the First District to attend "Classroom to Career: Developing Tomorrow's Female Leaders", an after school program designed to address the skills gap that is currently in today's job market place.
