BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Riverside Community College District Foundation - \$1,000** funding will be used to continue the foundations efforts to provide scholarship and programmatic support to Riverside Community College District students that reside in the First District.
2. **Riverside County Philharmonic Association, Inc. - \$2,500** funding will be used to support "Music in the Community" a community outreach program that brings music into classrooms in the 1st District.
3. **Riverside County Regional Medical Center SART/RCCAT - \$1,500** funding will be used to support the 3rd Annual Sexual Assault Response Team (SART)/Riverside County Child Assessment Team (RCCAT) Conference. The goal of the conference is to raise community awareness of the growing epidemic of abuse and the services offered by the County. Attendees will include physicians, nurses, social workers, law enforcement, advocates, prosecutors, and others. 200 attendees are expected to attend.
4. **Black History Month Committee of Riverside - \$1,000** funding will be used to support the Riverside Black History Parade and Expo on 2/14/15. This event is free and open to the public.
