BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County Transportation Improvement Program provides for road improvements to Highland Springs Avenue, between Brookside Avenue and Cherry Valley Boulevard in the Community of Cherry Valley. The project consists of removal of existing pavement, placing new hot mix asphalt concrete, placing of asphalt concrete dike, and reconstruction of noncompliant curb ramps to conform with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards. Traffic improvements will include new signing, striping, pavement markings and other work as may be required.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel, and environmental clearance is complete.

Project Number: C1-0582

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The proposed improvements will benefit the project area by significantly improving the service life of the existing infrastructure, as well as providing upgrades to enhance pedestrian safety with ADA compliant ramps.

The work is scheduled to begin in mid-2015. The work will be phased to keep the roads open during construction and will take approximately four weeks to complete.

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$280,000, and construction is expected to finish in Fiscal Year 2015/2016 and will be funded with Gas Tax (ABX8-9 Mar 2010 New HUTA).
