SUBJECT: Authorization and Approval of Resolution No. 2015-056, Appointing Applicable Member to the Riverside County Redevelopment Successor Agency Oversight Board.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Authorize and approve Resolution No. 2015-056, Appointing Aaron Hake to the Successor Agency Oversight Board for the Riverside County Redevelopment Agency successor Agency. He is replacing Ed Sloman who retired.
- 2) Authorize transmittal of notice of appointment under the Board of Supervisor's discretion to the Department of Finance by the Chairman.

BACKGROUND: The ruling by the Supreme Court of California issued on December 29, 2011, validated AB 1x 26, which dissolves Redevelopment Agencies effective February 1, 2011. The companion bill, AB 1x 27, was invalidated in the same ruling. Pursuant to California Health and Safety Code § 34179, each county successor agency shall have an oversight board comprised of seven members.

BACKGROUND: (Continued)

The seven members shall be selected as follows:

- 1) One member appointed by the Board of Supervisors:
- 2) One member of the public appointed by the County Board of Supervisors:
- 3) One member representing employees of the fanner redevelopment agency appointed by the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, from the recognized employee organization representing the largest number of former redevelopment agency employees employed by the successor agency at that time:
- 4) One member appointed by the largest special district by property tax share, with territory in the territorial jurisdiction of the fanner redevelopment agency, which is of the type of special district that is eligible to receive property tax revenues pursuant to§ 34188;
- 5) One member appointed by the County Superintendent of Education:
- One member appointed by the Chancellor of the California Community Colleges; and. 6)
- 7) One member selected by the largest city by acreage in the territorial jurisdiction of the former redevelopment agency;

The appointments within this submittal concern those that the Board of Supervisors has authorization to appoint: One member appointed by the Board of Supervisors, one member of the public appointed by Board of Supervisors, and one member representing employees of the former redevelopment agency appointed by the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors. This provides a total of three appointments under the Board of Supervisors' discretion.

If approved by the Board, Aaron Hake, will serve as a member of the public. This appointment to the County's Successor Agency Oversight Board will meet the Board of Supervisor's appointment obligation. If approved, notice of the appointment will be sent by the Clerk of the Board to the Department of Finance.

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-056

RESOLUTION APPOINTING APPLICABLE MEMBERS TO THE RIVERSIDE COUNTY REDEVELOPMENT SUCCESSOR AGENCY OVERSIGHT BOARD

WHEREAS, on June 29, 2011, Governor Brown signed two State of California Assembly Bills, ABX1 26 and ABX1 27, which, respectively, dissolved redevelopment agencies throughout the state of California, and created an alternative voluntary redevelopment program that would allow agencies to continue redevelopment activity by voluntarily making a payment to the state;

WHEREAS, on July 18, 2011, the California Redevelopment Association (CRA) and the League of California Cities (League) filed a petition which requested that the California Supreme Court (Court) overturn ABX1 26 and ABX1 27 on the grounds that the bills violated the California Constitution (California Redevelopment Association v. Matosantos [Case]);

WHEREAS, the Court heard oral arguments in the case on November 10, 2011:

WHEREAS, on December 29, 2011, the Court announced its decision to uphold ABX1 26 and strike down ABX1 27, thus eliminating redevelopment agencies;

WHEREAS, on January 10, 2012, the Board of Supervisors accepted the designation as Successor Agency for the Redevelopment Agency for the County of Riverside;

WHEREAS, pursuant to ABX1 26, Chapter 4, Section 34179, each successor agency shall have an oversight board composed of seven members;

WHEREAS, further pursuant to ABX1 26, Chapter 4, Section 34179, the Board of Supervisors may appoint members of the oversight board as follows:

a) One member appointed by the County Board of Supervisors;

- b) One member of the public appointed by the County Board of Supervisors;
- c) One member of the former redevelopment agency appointed by the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors from the recognized employee organization representing the largest number of former redevelopment agency employees employed by the successor agency at that time; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors wishes to appoint members to the oversight board to the Successor Agency for the Redevelopment Agency for the County of Riverside.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, AND DETERMINED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside as follows:

Section 1. Appointment by the Board of Supervisors. The Riverside County Board of Supervisors appoints Aaron Hake, a Riverside County resident, to the Oversight Board as a representative of the Board of Supervisors. Aaron Hake will be replacing Ed Sloman who retired and moved out of state.

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect as of February 10, 2015.
