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BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

As a result of changing groundwater conditions at both landfills, the CRWQCB is requiring the Department to construct two new groundwater monitoring wells at the Closed Mead Valley Landfill and one new groundwater monitoring well at the Badlands Sanitary Landfill. Pursuant to the CRWQCB's requirement, the Department submitted Workplans to the CRWQCB, which described the proposed well locations and well construction schematics. The CRWQCB subsequently approved the Department's Workplans. A specialized California Contractor's License (C-57), which the Department does not have, is required to install groundwater monitoring wells.

The Engineer's estimate for this project is \$85,000.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The contract ensures that the subject landfills maintain compliance with environmental regulations enforced by the CRWQCB.
