17 The above-captioned matter came on regularly for hearing on March 24, 2015, before the
18 Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California in the Board Room, First Floor
19 Annex, County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California regarding the real
20 property described as 3 Parcels North West of 64635 16th Avenue, Desert Hot Springs, Riverside
21 County, and further described as Assessor's Parcel Number 666-050-010 referred to hereinafter as
22 "THE PROPERTY."

23 Sophia Choi, Deputy County Counsel, appeared along with Michelle Cervantes, Senior Code
24 Enforcement Officer, on behalf of the Director of the Code Enforcement Department.

25 Owner did not appear.

26 The Board of Supervisors received the Declaration of Code Enforcement Officer together
27 with the attached exhibits, evidencing the accumulation of rubbish on THE PROPERTY as a public
28 nuisance and violation of Riverside County Ordinance No. 541.

1 **SUMMARY OF EVIDENCE**

2 1. Documents of record in the Riverside County Recorder’s Office identify the OWNER
3 of THE PROPERTY as T.H. Construction, LLC (“OWNER”).

4 2. Documents of title indicate that no other parties potentially hold a legal interest in
5 THE PROPERTY.

6 3. THE PROPERTY was inspected by Code Enforcement Officers on April 28, 2012
7 and on fifteen (15) additional occasions, the last being March 12, 2015.

8 4. During each inspection, an accumulation of rubbish was observed on THE
9 PROPERTY. The rubbish consisted of, but was not limited to: tires, discarded furniture, discarded
10 household items, scrap wood, a boat, green waste and miscellaneous household items.

11 5. THE PROPERTY was determined to be in violation of Riverside County Ordinance
12 No. 541 by the Code Enforcement Officer.

13 6. A Notice of Pendency of Administrative Proceedings was recorded in the Office of
14 the County Recorder, County of Riverside, State of California on September 7, 2012, as instrument
15 number 2012-0428532.

16 7. On April 28, 2012 and August 28, 2014, a Notice of Violation was posted on THE
17 PROPERTY. On May 3, 2012, a Notice of Violation was mailed to OWNER by U.S. mail and on
18 August 27, 2014, a Notice of Violation was mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested.

19 8. A “Notice to Correct County Ordinance Violations and Abate Public Nuisance”
20 providing notice of the public hearing before the Board of Supervisors on March 24, 2015, was
21 mailed to OWNER and was posted on THE PROPERTY.

22 **FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS**

23 WHEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in
24 regular session assembled on March 24, 2015, finds and concludes that:

25 1. WHEREAS, the accumulation of rubbish on the real property located at 3 Parcels
26 North West of 63635 16th Avenue, Desert Hot Springs, Riverside County, California, also identified
27 as Assessor's Parcel Number 666-050-010 violates Riverside County Ordinance No. 541 and
28 constitutes a public nuisance.
