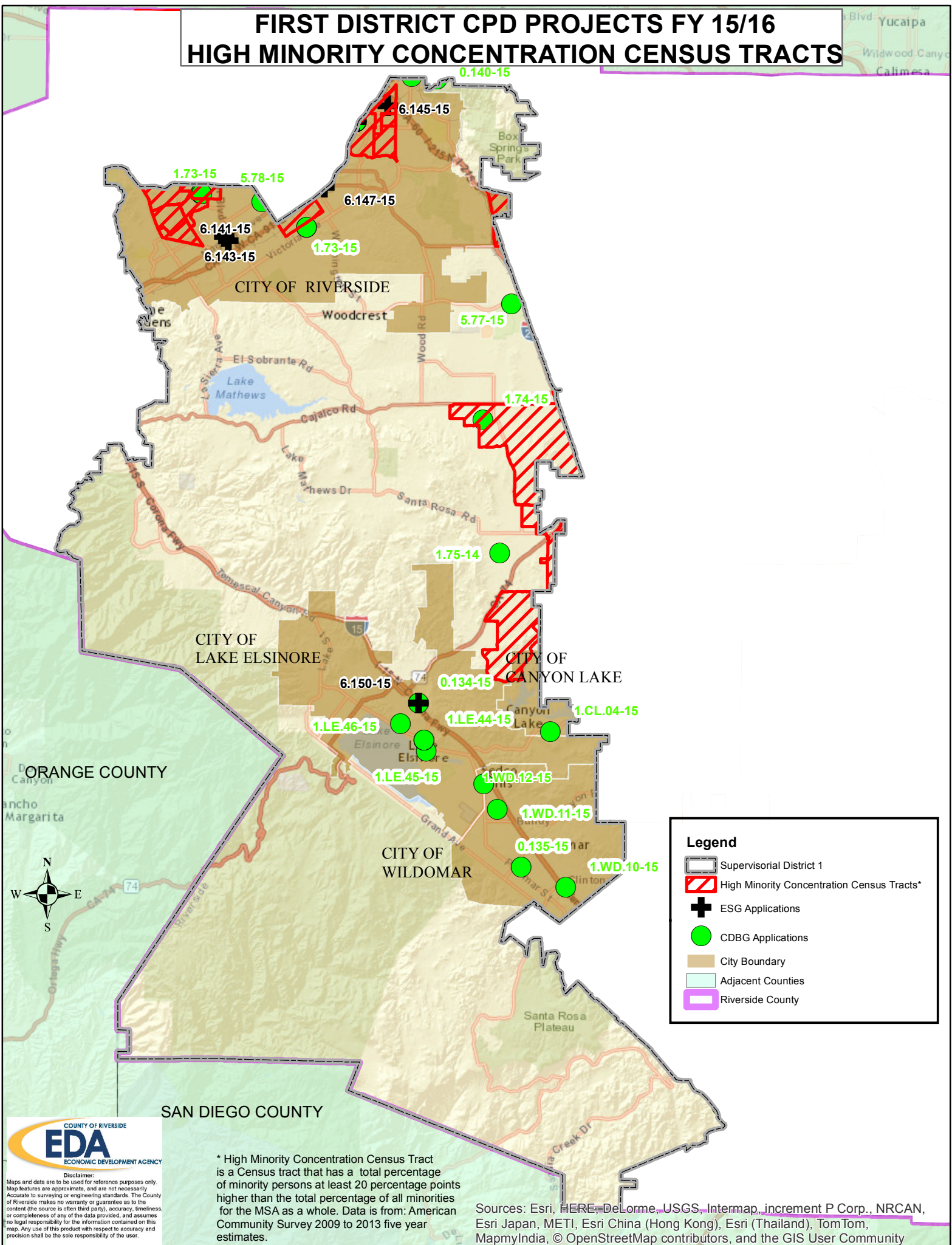

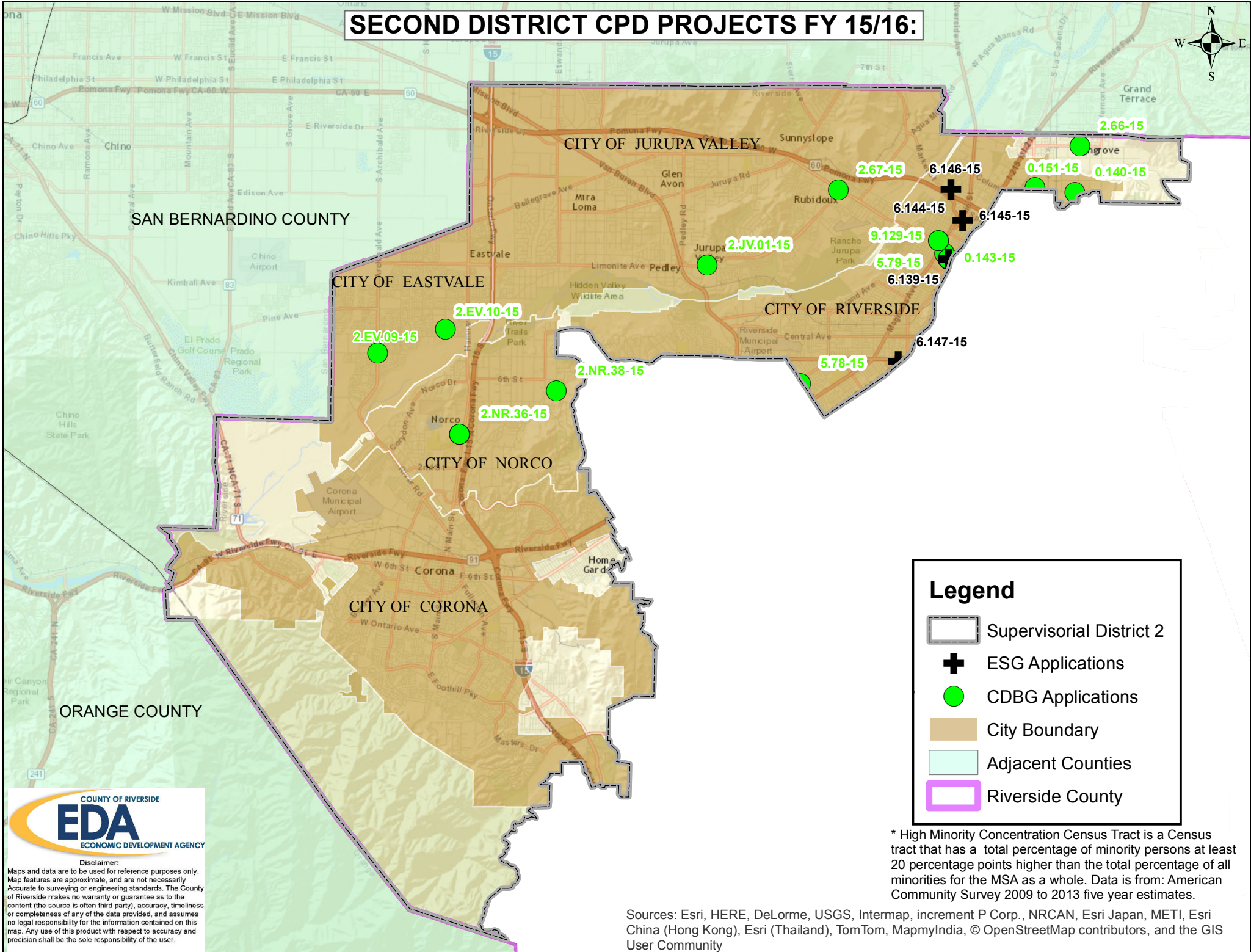

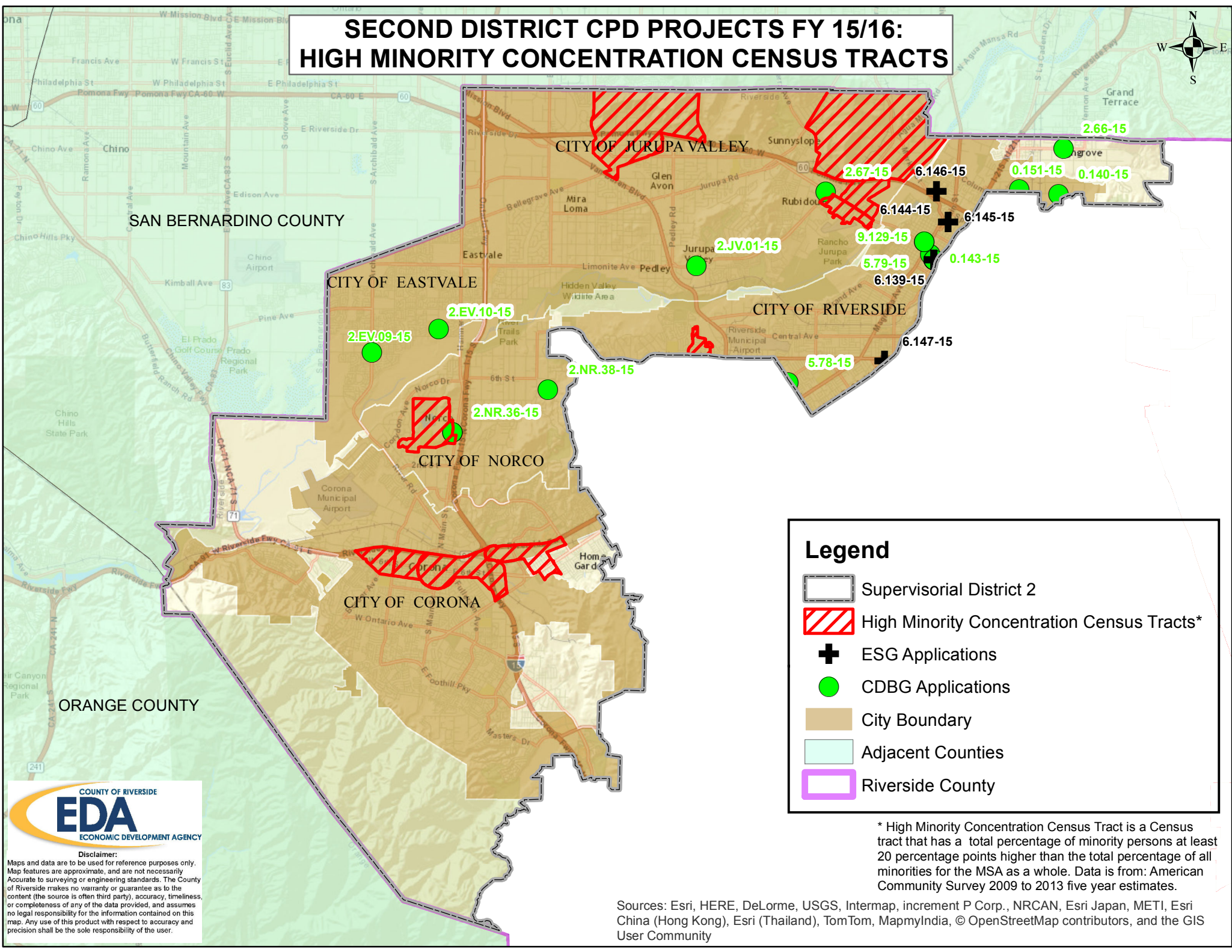
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# SECOND DISTRICT CPD PROJECTS FY 15/16: HIGH MINORITY CONCENTRATION CENSUS TRACTS

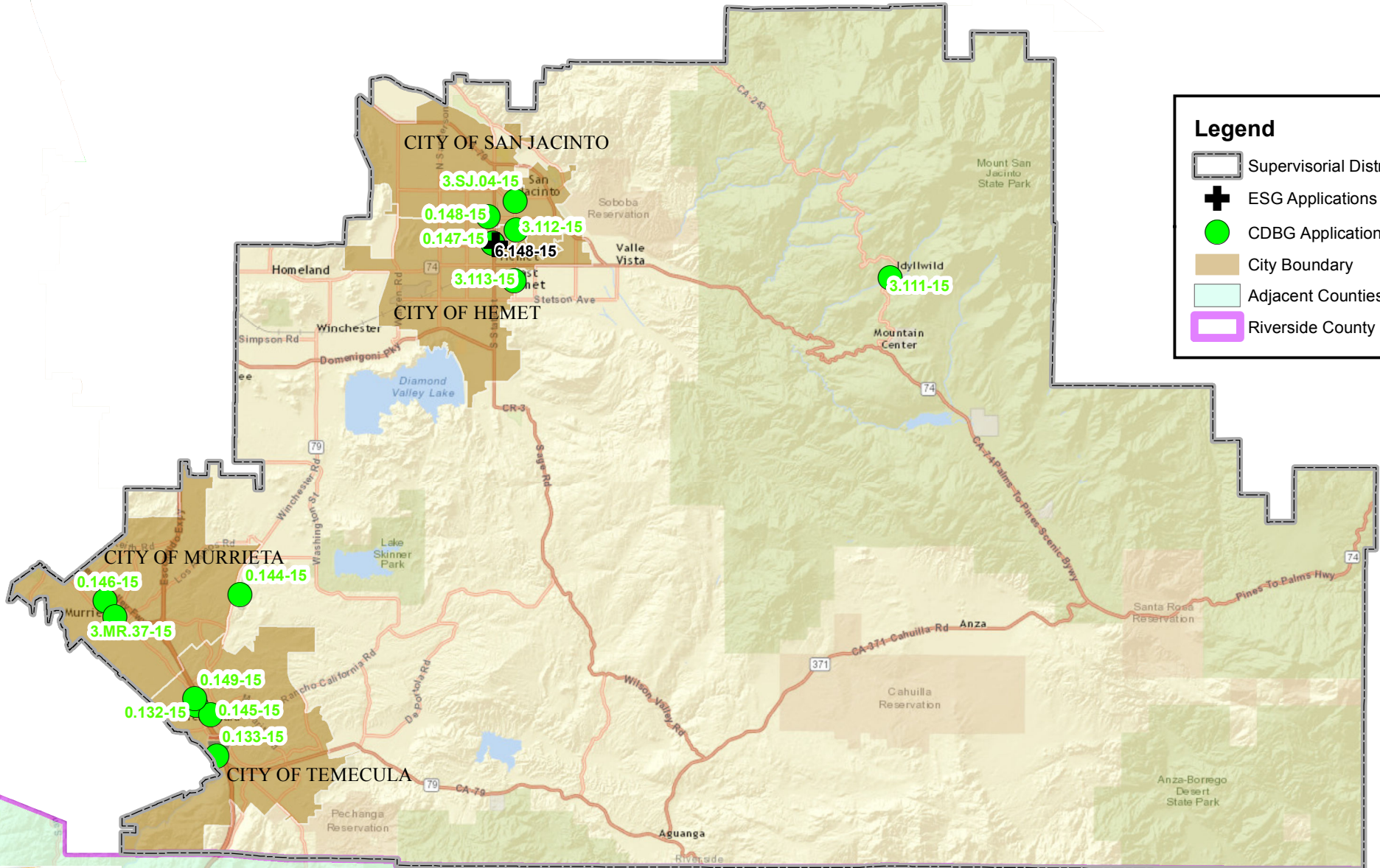

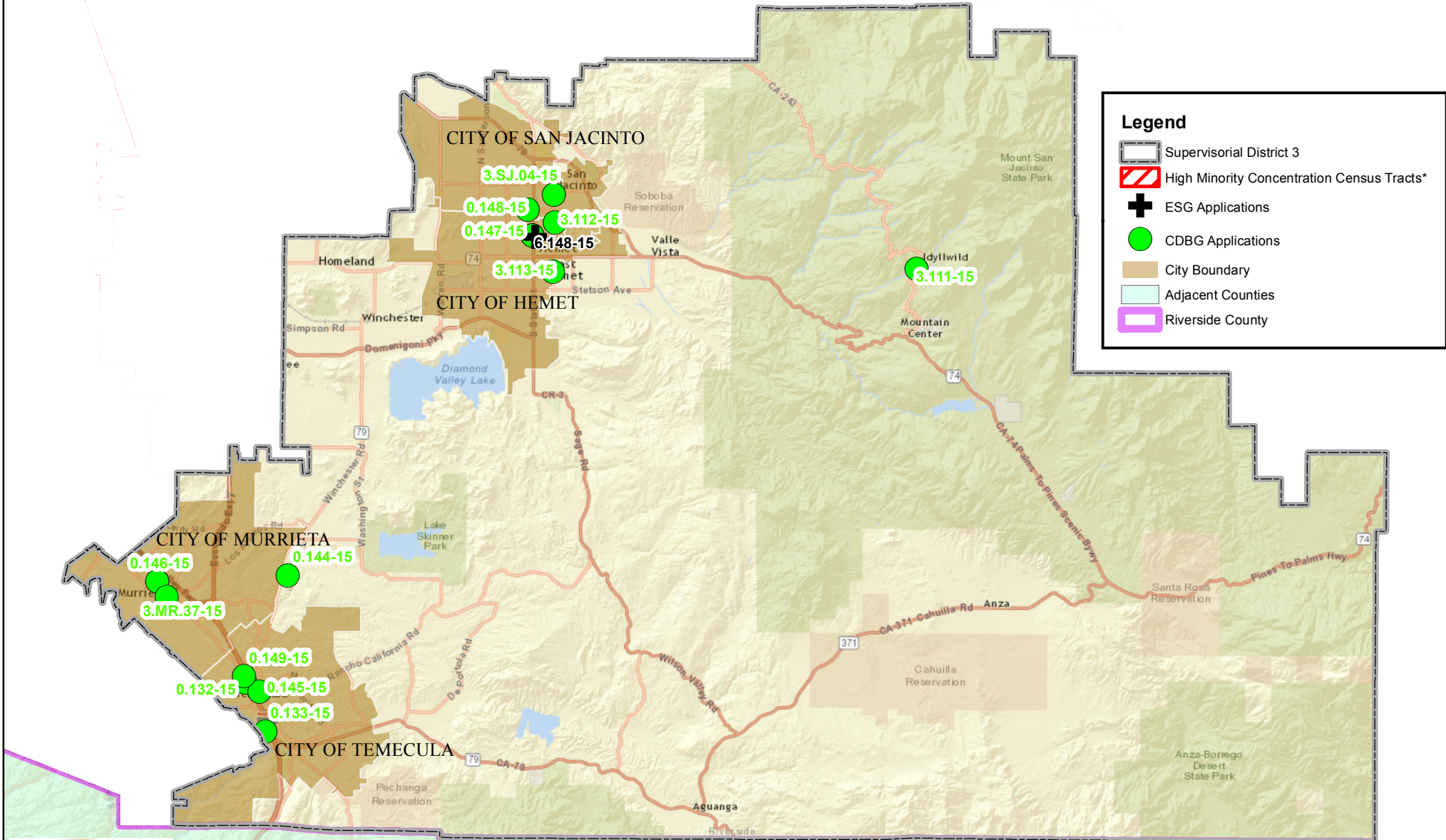

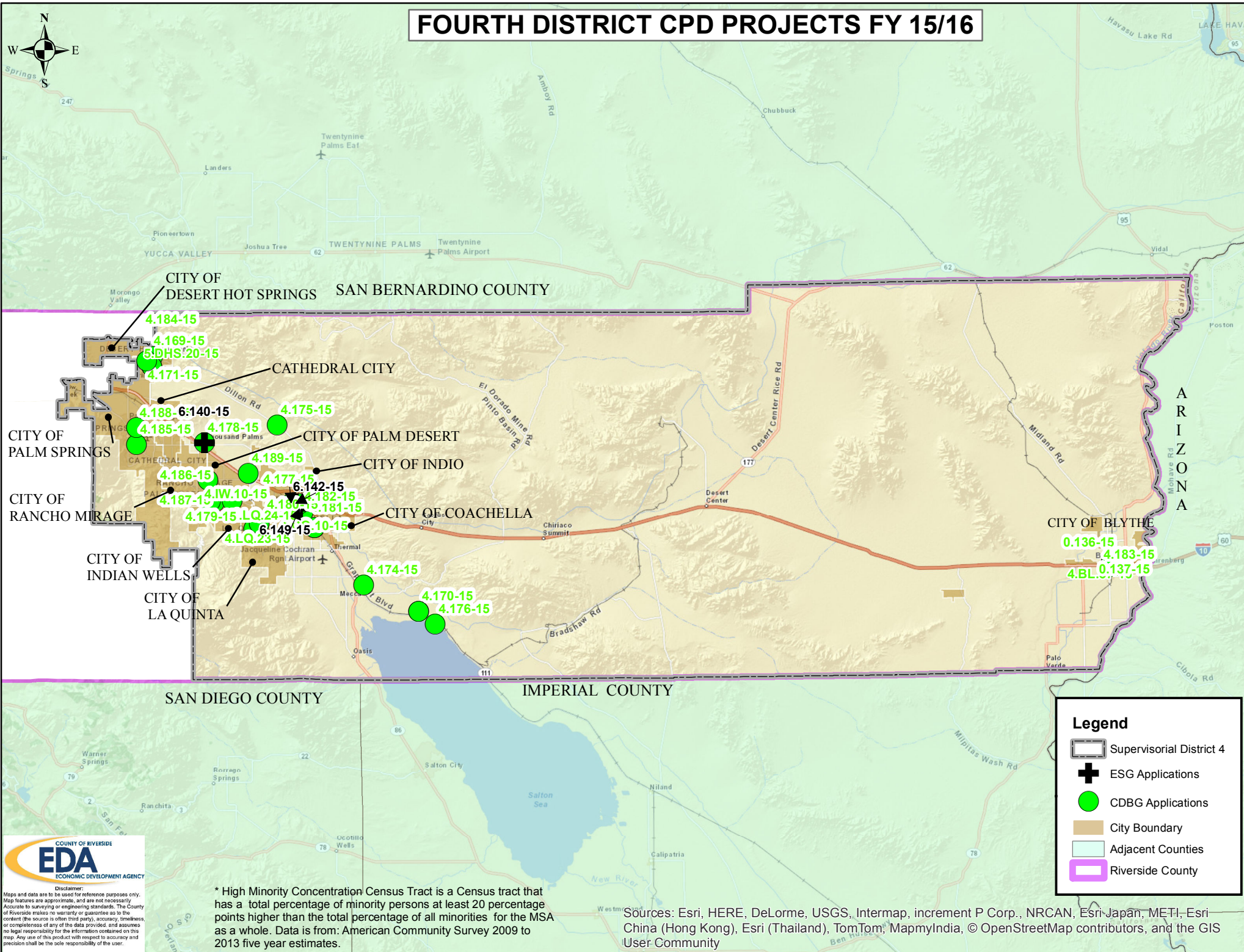

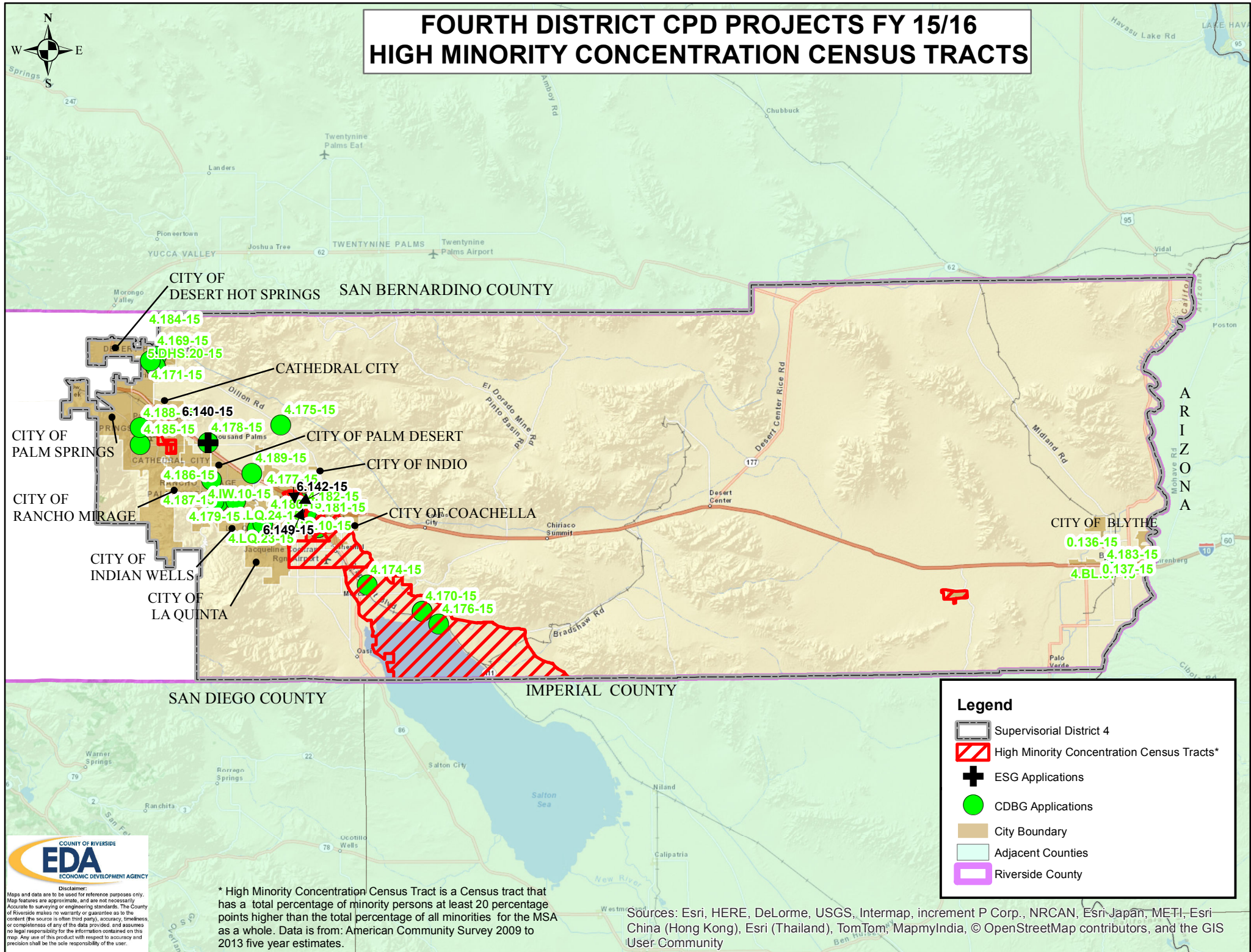

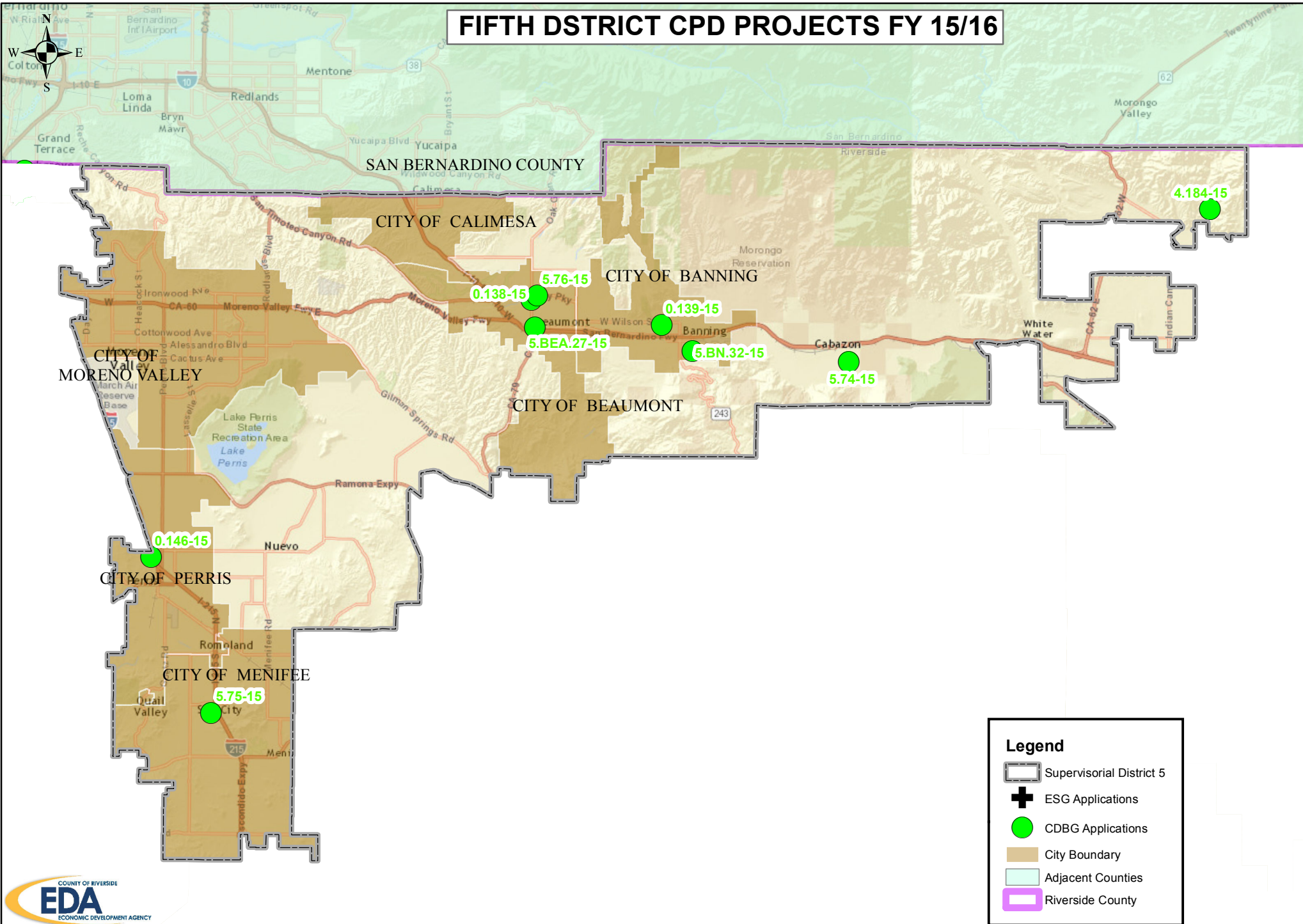

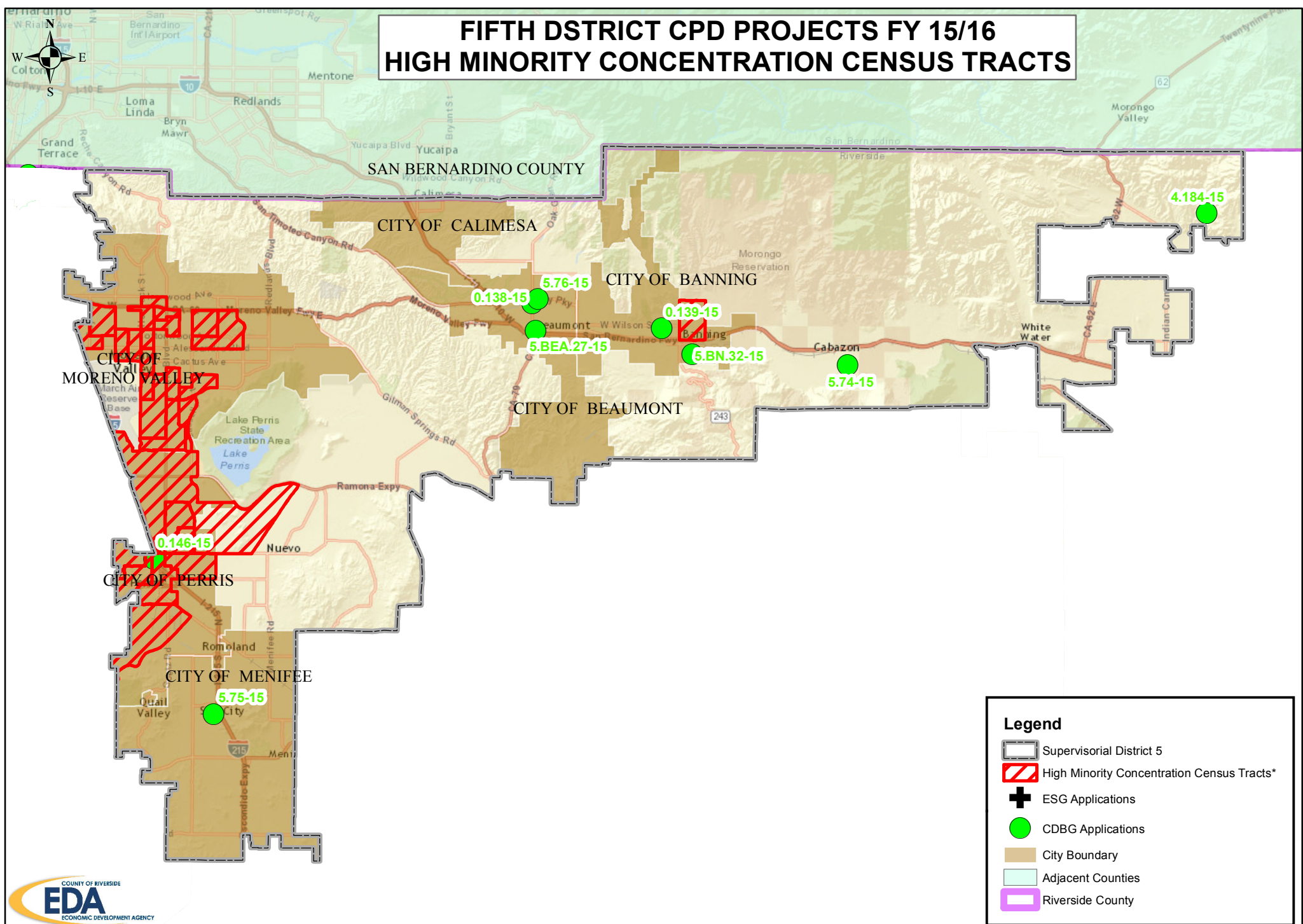
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# FIFTH DSTRCT CPD PROJECTS FY 15/16 HIGH MINORITY CONCENTRATION CENSUS TRACTS
