SUBJECT: Contract Award for the Completion of Groundwater Monitoring Well Construction at the Badlands Sanitary Landfill, Closed Mead Valley Sanitary Landfill and Closed Elsinore Sanitary Landfill, District 1,5 [\$121,025 – Waste Management Department Enterprise Funds]

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Accept the bid submitted by Yellow Jacket Drilling and award them the contract in the amount of \$121,025 for the installation of groundwater monitoring wells at Badlands Sanitary Landfill, Closed Mead Valley Sanitary Landfill and Closed Elsinore Sanitary Landfill; and
2. Authorize the Chairman to execute the Agreement on behalf of the Department.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Riverside County Waste Management Department (Department) is required by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board – Santa Ana Region (CRWQCB) to regularly monitor groundwater at the Badlands Sanitary Landfill, Closed Mead Valley Sanitary Landfill and Closed Elsinore Sanitary Landfill. BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

As a result of changing groundwater conditions at the Badlands Sanitary Landfill and the Closed Mead Valley Sanitary Landfill, the CRWQCB is requiring the Department to construct new groundwater monitoring wells. Two new groundwater monitoring wells will be constructed at the Closed Mead Valley Landfill and one new groundwater monitoring well will be constructed at the Badlands Sanitary Landfill.

The Board approved the Department to advertise the project on February 10, 2015. The engineer's estimate for the project was \$85,000. During the advertisement period, the Department issued two (2) Addendums.

Addendum No. 1 extended the bidding period and included a change in the scope of work by adding groundwater monitoring well construction at the Closed Elsinore Sanitary Landfill. A residential development, currently in the entitlement process, is planned for the property north of the landfill. The development includes grading for a future road to be located in close proximity to an existing groundwater monitoring well that is just outside of our property line. Therefore, the Department needs to abandon the existing well and replace it by constructing a new well. The funds for this groundwater monitoring well abandonment and replacement at the Closed Elsinore Sanitary Landfill are already included in the Department's budget for Fiscal Year 2014/2015. The Engineer's estimate for this project was revised to include Addendum No. 1. The revised Engineer's estimate is \$124,000.

Addendum No. 2 provided answers to bidder questions.

The Department received two bids at the bid opening:

Contractor	Total Bid Amount
Yellow Jacket Drilling	\$121,025
BC2 Environmental	\$141,107

Department staff has determined that Yellow Jacket Drilling has the necessary experience and capability to construct the projects and County Counsel has determined that the submitted bid documents are approved as to form. Yellow Jacket Drilling's bid is the lowest, responsible bid and is less than the revised Engineer's Estimate. The Contract Agreement between the County and Yellow Jacket Drilling is attached herewith.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The contract ensures that the subject landfills maintain compliance with environmental regulations enforced by the CRWQCB.

Additional Fiscal Information

The project cost was competitively bid through the California Public Works Contract process.

These projects are budgeted in Fund 40200, Department ID – 4500100000.

AGREEMENT


THIS AGREEMENT is made as of _____ (date)

Contractor shall furnish all tools, equipment, apparatus, facilities, labor and material necessary to perform the work for the project, Completion of Groundwater Monitoring Well Construction at the Badlands Sanitary Landfill and Closed Mead Valley Sanitary Landfill, in exact conformity with the Contract Documents, subject to such inspection as County deems appropriate.

 - (n) Orders, instructions, drawings and plans issued by County during the course of the work in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents.
3. Each of the above-mentioned documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated into this Agreement and each of these documents not now in existence are incorporated herein as of the time of their issuance.
4. Contract Price - Payment. Exhibit A is attached to and incorporated into this Agreement and states the basis for full payment to Contractor. Contractor represents that it fully understands the payment method for the work.
