MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

BACKGROUND:

1. Anza Valley Christian Men's Service Club - \$2,500 – The funding will provide assistance with the distribution of United States Dept. of Agriculture Food Program for low-income individuals who reside in the Anza, Aguanga, Mountain Center and Pinyon areas.
2. Food for the Faithful - \$2,500 – Provides funding for the food distribution program for low- income families in the Anza and Aguanga areas. In addition, the program helps the homeless by providing clean clothing and hygiene products.
3. Foundation on Aging - \$21,710 – The funding will help preserve approximately 300 daily congregate and home delivered meals for seniors residing in the Hemet & San Jacinto Valley.
4. City of Hemet - \$5,000 – The funding will be used to assist with the costs related to the Hemet Holiday Parade which features the "Best of the Valley". Historically, the parade and holiday in the park includes nearly 3,000 residents and 10,000 spectators.
