BACKGROUND:
Summary

The Box Springs Mountain reserve is located within a rural community near Moreno Valley and is open to the public from dawn to dusk; residents have reported that groups of people visiting the park after hours have, at times, threatened public safety by engaging in illegal activities, littering, blocking the road and park areas, and causing vehicle collisions on Box Springs Mountain Road.

BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

Over the last year residents have reported an increase in nighttime activity and they frequently call the Sheriff, Moreno Valley Police Department, and CHP to respond to these illicit activities. To discourage the public from loitering in the park area after the park is closed, improve public safety, and to facilitate stronger enforcement, it is recommended that No Stopping, Tow Away zones be established on both sides of Box Springs Mountain Road, which is a narrow dirt access road maintained by the Transportation Department.

“No Parking Any Time” zones already exist along the same segment of Box Springs Mountain Road. The Transportation Department and the Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District have met with the affected residents and received support for the proposed measure.

Transportation Department staff has also contacted the California Highway Patrol (CHP) and the Riverside County Sheriff’s Department and received concurrence of the proposed measure from the agencies.

Upon approval of the resolution, the Transportation Department will install appropriate signs to give notice thereof.

Resolution No. 2015-172 has been reviewed and approved by County Counsel as to form.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The proposed No Stopping/Tow Away zones will improve safety within the community through enforcement. The proposed zones are expected to increase safety to the community.

8 **WHEREAS**, California Vehicle Code Section 22651(n) authorizes the establishment of
 9 "No Stopping/Tow Away" zones when necessary to ensure public safety; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the current "No Parking Any Time" designation along Box Springs Mountain
 11 Road, a narrow dirt roadway in the area of Box Springs Mountain Park, has been only minimally
 12 effective in deterring illegal parking; and

13 **WHEREAS**, it is necessary to facilitate a stronger enforcement mechanism to ensure
 14 adequate access for the affected residents and emergency vehicles: Now, therefore,

15 **BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED** by the Board of
 16 Supervisors, County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on
 17 _____ 2015, that the following No Stopping/Tow Away Zones are hereby
 18 established in the unincorporated Moreno Valley area:

- 19 1. On both sides of Box Springs Mountain Road beginning at a point 2,875 feet west
 20 of Pigeon Pass Road to the end of the county-maintained portion of Box Springs
 21 Mountain Road (near the parking lot of Box Springs Mountain Park), a total
 22 distance of approximately 3,850 feet.
- 23 2. The No Stopping/Tow Away Zone shall be in effect at all times, seven days a
 24 week.
