5 RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY
6 OF RIVERSIDE EXTENDING THE EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY

8 WHEREAS, Government Code section 8630, Article 14, of the California Emergency Services
9 Act requires that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside review, at least every thirty (30)
10 days until such Local Emergency is terminated, the need for continuing the Local Emergency; and

11 WHEREAS, a period of Local Emergency presently exists in the County of Riverside in
12 accordance with the proclamation thereof by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, by
13 Resolution No. 2015-178, on July 21, 2015, as a result of conditions of extreme peril to the safety of
14 persons and property within said county, caused by significant rainfall, flooding, mud and debris flows,
15 severe winds, road closures, damage to utilities, local businesses, critical public and private infrastructure
16 to include collapse of a bridge on to a major thoroughfare, within the County of Riverside; and

17 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside has reviewed the need to
18 continue the existence of the Local Emergency; and

19 WHEREAS, the situation resulting from said condition of extreme peril is still deemed to be
20 beyond the control of normal protective service, personnel, equipment, and facilities of and within said
21 County of Riverside; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside does hereby
proclaim the extension of the period of Local Emergency for thirty (30) additional days unless sooner
terminated.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that said Local Emergency shall be deemed to continue to exist
until its termination is proclaimed by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside.
