BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. Riverside County Regional Medical Center Foundation - \$2,500** funding will be used to assist in the purchase of specialized equipment.
- 2. Boys and Girls Club of Southwest County - \$1,500** funding will be used to support the “Enhanced Triple Play” program at the Alberhill Clubhouse, which serves approximately 100 First District children per day. The program focuses on improving childhood wellness through play, nutrition and social interaction.
- 3. Smiles for Seniors Foundation- \$1,000** to support their efforts of providing emergency assistance for food, housing and utility payments as well as home and auto repair, and help pay for life saving prescriptions, and medical equipment for senior citizens in the 1st District.
- 4. Riverside Art Council- \$1,000** funding will be used to support Long Night of Arts & Innovation, an event designed to inspire youth to pursue careers in the Arts and Sciences fields, it is a free public event.
