**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary (continued)**

1. The donation to the Riverside Educational Enrichment Foundation (REEF) will be used to help sponsor the Riverside Citrus Classic where more than \$20,000 will be raised to help enrich education and engage students in the classroom, by providing teacher grants so teachers can develop and fund programs and projects that best engage their students.
2. The donation to Community Connect will be used to sponsor the Non-Project Resource Center's (NRC) "Community of Collaboration Non-Profit Conference" where non-profit leaders learn to share resources related to viable community solutions, strengthen leadership skills and create valuable partnerships. The conference will help our local non-profits with strategic planning, management and other basic components that facilitate the development of a non-profit organization.
3. The donation to the FitOne Foundation will help them continue to provide free fitness classes to kids, high school students, at-risk youth, families and seniors. In addition, FitOne Foundation provides educational seminars, nutritional counseling and outreach to more than 1500 people.
4. The donation to the Corona Chamber of Commerce will help fund the 2015 Annual Women's Leadership Conference which will provide featured speakers and break-out learning sessions to help participants develop their inner power and enhancing their business savvy and leadership skills. This year's event will be held at the Riverside Convention Center and they are anticipating more than 400 attendees.
